Specifications for Petromat and Double Chip Seal

Reference Spec: Douglas County Standard Specification for Public Works Construction, edition 1996 All work shall be in conformance to the above with the following special conditions.

Petromat (or equal) stall be tractor placed in AR-4000 or AR-8000 oil applied at the rate of .35 to .40 gallons per square yard (gal / s.y.). The mat shall be rolled into the oil using pneumatic rollers until completely embedded. Excess pieces of mat not attached to the oil shall be trimmed off.

The binuminous material used for the double chip seal shall be Latex Modified CRS-2H and shall conform to Section 201. The first coat of emulsion shall be applied at the rate of .35-.40 gal / s.y. over the petromat. If the air temperature is warm enough to cause sticking of the personnt to the tires of the distributor truck, a parting agent may be used on the tires, or, alternatively, an application of 6 to 12 pounds per square yard (lbs. / s.y.) of 3/8 inch chips may be placed over the mat prior to the application of the emulsion. After the emulsion application, 3/8 inch chips meeting the requirements of subsection 200.02.05 with the addition that the chips shall be screw washed with the percentage passing the number 200 sieve not exceeding 0.5% shall be placed at the rate of 22 to 28 lbs. / s.y. in accordance with Section 317. Pneumatic tired rollers shall be used to embed the chips. A minimum of four coverages with these rollers will be required.

Prior to the second application of emulsion, all ridges, piles or any other accumulation of chips shall be swept off. There shall be a minimum of two hours of elapsed time between the first and second application of emulsion with the corresponding air temperature above 70 degrees. The second application of emulsion, using the same material as above shall be placed at the rate of .32 to .38 gal / s.y. Specification 3/8 inch chips shall be applied at the rate of 22 to 28 lbs / s.y., using pneumatic fired rollers for embedment. A minimum of five coverages will be required over this course.

All existing utility valve covers, boxes and lids shall be covered with a protective material prior to the application of any bituminous material. The protective material shall be removed and the covers exposed at the completion of the work.

"Loose Gravel" signs and "Speed Limit 25mph" signs will be required, alternately, at the beginning of the work and at each intersection. At no time shall there be more that 2500 feet between such warning signs.

No sweeping shall be performed on the same day that this process is completed. An initial sweeping shall be required on the first morning following this work, with a final sweep after a minimum of five days.
