13 RAINSBERGER who were both nominated by the decedent to serve as  
14 his Co-Executors, who qualify under the provisions of Section  
15 138.020 of NRS, and who have consented in writing to so serve, be  
16 appointed Co-Executors of the decedent's estate and that Letters  
17 Testamentary be issued to them upon their taking the oath  
18 required by law, without bond, bond having been expressly waived  
19 under the provisions of paragraph EIGHTH of the decedent's Last  
20 Will and Testament of September 18, 1996.
