GRANT OF IRREVOCABLE LICENSE

In consideration of the enforcement of the ban on the construction of new piers in Glenbrook Bay by the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency and subject to the limitations set forth herein, the GLENBROOK HOMEOWNERS' ASSOCIATION, a non-stock, non-profit Nevada cooperative corporation, hereby grants to all owners of littoral parcels fronting on Glenbrook Bay, a bay in Lake Tahoe, Douglas County, Nevada, as it is now or may be later defined by the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency, a non-exclusive, irrevocable license and right to use the Glenbrook Pier for recreational purposes only, said Glenbrook Pier being more particularly defined in that certain Quitclaim Deed for Glenbrook Pier recorded in the records of Douglas County bearing document number 163253 found in book 987 at pages 4482 and 4483.

The foregoing irrevocable license does not authorize use of the Glenbrook Pier for any commercial use and the use of said Pier shall be subject to the rules and regulations of the Glenbrook Homeowners' Association as now existing or which may be established in the future by the Glenbrook Homeowners' Association.

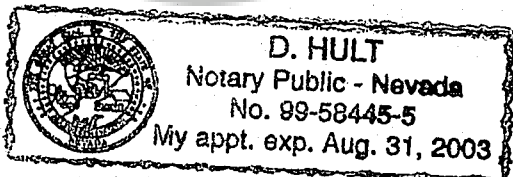
