LIMITED POWER OF ATTORNEY

WHEREAS, Harbor Financial Mortgage Corporation, a Texas corporation, ("Harbor") and/or Harbor Financial Group, Inc., NAF, Inc. ("NAF"), Hamilton Financial Services Corp., CalCap, Inc. and Community National Mortgage Corp. This Limited Power of Attorney is executed and effective as of the date appearing below, and shall continue in full force and effect and shall be binding upon any successors or assigns of the undersigned, notwithstanding of the continued existence or otherwise of the undersigned.


