This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 60576, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 60576, and with understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to The totalizing meter must be installed before any beneficial use. use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and is filed. maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of

ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 48320, 48321, 64881, 65762, 66657 and 67307 shall not exceed 95.84 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal

and local agencies.

The issuance of Permit 67307 reduces the total combined duty of Permits 60576; 60607; 60608; 60609; 60611, Certificate 15122; 60612; 60613, Certificate 15123; 60614; 60615, Certificate 15124; 64626, 64627 and 65007 to 2,023.06 million gallons annually. (CONTINUED ON PAGE 3)
