GENERAL POWER OF ATTORNEY

To maintain, repair, improve, manage, insure, rent, lease, sell, convey, subject to liens, mortgage, subject to deeds of trust, and hypothecate, and in any way or manner deal with all of any part of any real or personal property whatsoever, tangible or intangible, or any interest therein, that I now own or may hereafter acquire, for use, on my behalf, and in my name and under such terms and conditions, and under such covenants, as said attorney in fact shall deem proper;
- 5. To conduct, engage in, and transact any and all lawful business of whatever nature or kind for me, on my behalf, and in my name;
