



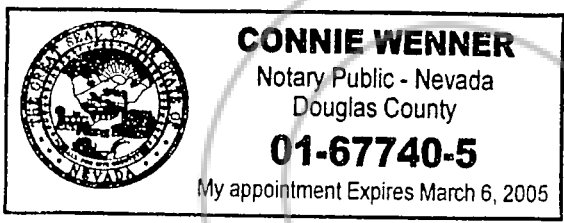

**ORDER AFTER
HEARING TO SHOW CAUSE**

15 THIS MATTER came before the court for hearing September 23,
16 2002, upon the application by the Douglas County District Attorney's
17 office on behalf of Charles Harner for defendant Sylvia T. Coleman,
18 aka Sylvia Louise Davis, to appear and show cause why she should not
19 be held in contempt for failure to obey that order and judgment filed
20 January 26, 1996, obligating her to pay \$100 each month for ongoing
21 child support and payment of an additional \$25 each month toward
22 arrears owing for the support of her minor daughter, Desiree Harner.

23 The defendant, Sylvia Davis, appeared before the court
24 without counsel. Also present was Charles Harner, custodial parent.
25 Appearing for the district attorney's office was Kris Brown, child
26 support caseworker, and Evan Beavers, Esq., Deputy District Attorney
27 for child support enforcement.

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1 This matter was last before the court February 4, 2002, for
2 Ms. Davis to show cause why she should not be held in contempt for
3 failure to pay child support. At that time she appeared with her
4 husband, Cliff Davis, who agreed to have his wages garnished for the
5 benefit of her child support obligation. The matter is again before
6 the court upon the allegation by the district attorney's office that
7 Mr. Davis' wages are being attached for child support obligations
8 owing in other cases and that there have been no withholdings from Mr.
9 Davis' wages for the benefit of Desiree Harner. According to Ms.
10 Brown the only payment received since February when this case was last
11 before the court was a payment of \$57.69 taken through wage
12 withholding on Ms. Davis' earnings in June of 2002.

13 Ms. Davis testified that she thought the wage withholding
14 on Mr. Davis was paying her child support obligation. This testimony
15 was contrary to the testimony of Ms. Brown who stated she told Ms.
16 Davis in May that the wages taken out of Mr. Davis' paychecks for
17 child support were not going to benefit Desiree or the obligation of
18 Ms. Davis.

19 Based upon the foregoing the court finds Sylvia Louise Davis
20 to be in contempt of court for failing to pay child support as
21 required by that order of January 26, 1996, and good cause appearing
22 therefore,


23 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Sylvia Louise Davis shall be
24 sentenced to two (2) days incarceration in the Douglas County Jail,
25 which sentence is suspended on the condition that she pay \$100 each
26 month for ongoing support plus \$35 each month toward arrears. The
27 first payment of \$135 must be received by Friday, September 27, 2002,
28 and she shall pay \$135 on or before October 15, 2002, and the same

1 amount on or before the 15th day of each month thereafter, until
2 further order of the court. Judgment shall be entered against Sylvia
3 Louise Davis in the amount of \$4,271.86 for arrears through September
4 30, 2002.
