15 **RECOMMENDATIONS FOR SUPPORT**

16 THIS MATTER having regularly come for hearing before the Master on the 12th day  
17 of July, 2002; the Petitioner/Obligee (ROBERT B. WOODARD) being () present ( ) not  
18 present; and the Respondent/Obligor (MICHELLE ANN TIETJE) being duly served and  
19 () present ( ) not present, and represented by proper person and Evan Beavers,  
20 Deputy District Attorney; of the Douglas County District Attorney's Office appearing and  
21 representing the State of Nevada's interest in the support and welfare of the child(ren)  
22 pursuant to law. After hearing all of the evidence and being fully advised in the premises,  
23 the Master makes the following findings and recommendations:

24 **FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

25 1. () The Court has jurisdiction of the parties and of the subject matter of this

1 2. (✓) The Respondent/Obligor (TIETJE) is the parent of:

2 ROBERT BRUCE WOODARD IV; born: October 5, 1990, and  
3 RYAN JAMES WOODARD; born: October 5, 1990.

4 3. (✓) The Respondent/Obligor (TIETJE) has a duty to support the above-  
5 named child/ren.

6 4. (✓) The Petitioner/Obligee (WOODARD) owes support arrears to the  
7 Respondent/Obligor (TIETJE) in the amount of \$ 16,831.12 from prior order  
8 through July 2002.

9 5. (✓) The Respondent/Obligor's (TIETJE'S) Gross Monthly Income is  
10 \$ 2,430.00 and 25 % of that amount is \$ 607.50.

11 6. (✓) The Respondent/Obligor's (TIETJE'S) child support obligation pursuant  
12 to NRS 125B.070, NRS 125B.080, or Existing Order is \$ 607.50.

13 7. ( ) The amount of the child support obligation determined by the Master

7 County District Attorney's Office, Child Support Division, at 775-782-9881, of any changes  
8 of address, employment or change in the availability of health insurance coverage within  
9 ten (10) days of such change.

10 8. (  ) **THIS IS AN INCOME WITHHOLDING ORDER.** A mandatory wage  
11 withholding shall be initiated against the Petitioner/Obligee's and Respondent/Obligor's  
12 wages or commissions. This does not preclude the use of other means to collect any  
13 arrears or enforce this order, including garnishment, liens, attachments, execution on real  
14 or personal property or interception of Federal Income Tax refunds.

15 9. (  ) **GOOD CAUSE BEING FOUND BY THE COURT:** See

17 said wage withholding shall be postponed until such time as the Petitioner/Obligee /  
18 Resondent/Obligor becomes (30) days delinquent in payment. **NO CREDIT WILL BE**  
19 **GIVEN FOR PAYMENTS NOT MADE BY WAGE/INCOME WITHHOLDING OR**  
20 **DIRECTLY THROUGH THE OFFICE OF THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY OR OTHER CHILD**  
21 **SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT AGENCY.**

22 10. (  ) Pursuant to NRS 125B.145, this order must be reviewed every three (3)  
23 years, upon the request of either party, and is subject to modification or review and  
24 adjustment as provided by law.

25 11. ( ) Unless a stay of the Order is obtained rom the District court, all  
26 enforcement procedures, including but no limited to wage withholding, garnishments, liens  
27 and the interception Federal Income Tax refunds, will be undertake upon entry of this  
28 order.

1 12. ( ) Interest upon the amount of the judgement for arrears shall accrue at the  
2 rate set by NRS 99.040.

3 13. ( ) Prejudgment interest is awarded from \_\_\_\_\_ through \_\_\_\_\_  
4 at the rate set by NRS 99.040 and based on the Affidavit of Arrears presented in these  
5 proceedings.

6 14. ( ) Interest is not ordered based on undue hardship on the Petitioner/Obligee

24 license number, and the name, address and telephone number of their employer.

25 **IT IS FURTHER RECOMMENDED THAT:**

26 *The support obligation shall not be enforced*  
27 *because of The substantial arrears owed by Mr.*  
28 *Woodard. The Magster does not enter a Custodial*



1 recommendation, which is more appropriately  
2 resolved in the district court.
