The second was the 18 trial on the merits of Plaintiff's action against Renae White. This Court previously severed 19 Plaintiff's claims against Frank S. Settlemeyer & Sons, Inc., (FSS) pursuant to N.R.C.P. 20 20(b). Having read and considered the pleadings, having heard the testimony of witnesses, 21 having considered the documentary evidence offered into evidence, and having entered 22 Findings and Fact and Conclusion of Law based upon said evidence, the Court enters 23 Judgment in favor of Marie Layton, and against Karen White, and Renae White, jointly and 24 severally, as follows: 25 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED: 26 1. The transfers of the 13,600 shares of stocks owned by Marvin Settelmeyer in

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FSS, 176 shares of PG&E, 219 shares of Portland General Electric, and 928.564 shares of

Eaton-Vance stock, as arranged by Karen White between August 9, 1996 and August 28,

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to N.R.C.P. 70, the 30,000 shares of stock are hereby vested in Richard Settelmeyer, who

1	remains alive.
2	8. Marie Layton is awarded compensatory economic damages against Karen
3	White and Renae White, jointly and severally in the amount of \$352,228.
4	9. Marie Layton is awarded compensatory non-economic damages against Karen
5	White and Renae White, jointly and severally in the amount of \$ 500. 60 for severe
6	and extreme emotional distress, humiliation, embarrassment, mental anguish, anger, and
7	shame.
8	10. Marie Layton is awarded punitive damages against Karen White in the amount
9 ·	of \$ 20.00.00
10	11. Within 30 days following the service of the notice of entry of this judgment,
11	Plaintiff shall file any motion for attorney's fees she seeks.
12	12. Judgment shall bear interest at the judgment rate from the date of the service of
13	the original summons and complaint, which is March 16, 1999.
