This matter came before the court October 28, 2003, upon application by the Douglas County District Attorney's Child Support Enforcement Office on behalf of the State of California and Michelle D. Bolin to summon Johnny C. Bolin to appear and show cause why he should not be held in contempt of court for failure to pay support for Bobby C. Bolin, born October 8, 1982, pursuant to that certain order from the Superior Court for Stanislaus County, California, dated May 6, 2003. The defendant, Johnny C. Bolin, was present without counsel and the State of California was represented by Evan Beavers, deputy district attorney for child support enforcement. Also present was Kris Brown, case worker for the district attorney's office.

According to the application and the briefing offered by Mr. Beavers, the original obligation for Mr. Bolin to support his minor child was entered December 29, 1998, in Stanislaus County, California, and the monthly support obligation was set at \$343 each month. The

minor child emancipated in October 2000, and during the years 2001 and 2002 Douglas County District Attorney's Office made various efforts, without success, for the defendant to comply with repayment agreements to avoid suspension of his driver's license for nonpayment of child support. In May 2003 the Stanislaus County Superior Court adjudicated arrears in the amount of \$3,611.22 and ordered payment on those arrears at the rate of \$75 each month. According to the Application for an Order to Show Cause in August 2003 the defendant had made no payments on that adjudicated arrearage.

In his defense Mr. Bolin explained that without a driver's license he could not work and that he subsisted on unemployment benefits through the end of 2002 and since that time had been subsisting on odd jobs for cash payment. He admitted to not having any physical disability and that he had last looked for full time employment a few months prior to the hearing.

Based upon the foregoing the court finds the defendant, Johnny C. Bolin, to be willfully underemployed and in contempt of court for failing to pay child support as required by the orders of the Superior Court of California for Stanislaus County, and good cause appearing therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the imposition of 20 days incarceration for contempt of court shall be, and the same hereby is, suspended on the following conditions:

- 1. Defendant shall pay \$100 on or before November 5, 2003, and each month thereafter, toward arrears adjudicated at \$3,611.22;
- Defendant shall secure employment with a wage identifiable for the district attorney's office to effect a wage withholding for the payment of child support.
