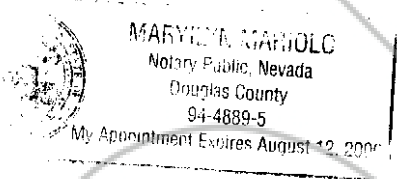

ORDER AFTER HEARING
TO SHOW CAUSE

14 MICHAEL VADEN COX,

17 THIS MATTER came before the court upon application by the Douglas
18 County District Attorney's Child Support Enforcement Office on behalf
19 of the State of California and Susan J. Holt for the defendant Michael
20 Vaden Cox to appear and show cause why he should not be held in
21 contempt of court for failure to pay child support as required by that
22 certain order of the California Superior Court for Colusa County
23 entered November 30, 1994.

24 The defendant, Michael Vaden Cox, was in the custody of the
25 Douglas County jailer on unrelated charges and was brought to appear
26 for the hearing. Evan Beavers, deputy district attorney for child
27 support enforcement was present for the State of California.

28 According to the application for this hearing and the case
history provided by Mr. Beavers, an order was entered in Colusa
County, California on November 30, 1994 obligating Mr. Cox to pay \$122
each month for the support of Michelle Francis Cox, born July 16,

1 1987. In October 2002 the district attorney's office received the
2 case from California but was able to only briefly withhold on an
3 identified wage for Mr. Cox before he quit his employment in March
4 2003. At the time of the hearing to show cause Mr. Cox's arrears for
5 child support amounted to \$10,908.77.

6 In his defense Mr. Cox explained that he had recently been
7 working for an auto repair shop in Carson City but he did not
8 anticipate having that job when he was expected to be released from
9 custody March 20, 2004. He stated that upon his release he
10 anticipated living in a half-way house through the services of
11 Manpower, Inc.

12 Mr. Beavers reminded the court and the defendant that the amounts
13 in arrears are sufficient to warrant a felony prosecution for non-
14 support if Mr. Cox fails to begin payment on his arrears. The court
15 admonished the defendant to begin paying child support on a regular
16 basis as soon as possible or face prosecution and reminded the
17 defendant that the penalty upon conviction for non-payment of child
18 support is one to six years in prison.

19 Based upon the foregoing the court finds the defendant Michael
20 Vaden Cox to be in contempt of court for failure to pay child support
21 as ordered by the Superior Court of California for Colusa County on
22 November 30, 1994, and good cause appearing therefore,

23 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the defendant shall be sentenced to 20
24 days incarceration in the Douglas County jail, which sentence is
25 suspended on the condition that he begin making regular payments
26 toward his obligation for support upon his release from custody and
27 that he keep the Douglas County District Attorney's Child Support
28 Enforcement Office current as to his physical address, mailing

1 address, and all necessary information regarding his employment.
