If the payment is in the form of a cashier's check, certified check, or money order, it must be made payable to the STATE COLLECTIONS AND DISBURSEMENT UNIT (SCaDU), identified by the Defendant's name and Social Security Number or Case No. 4581A, and it must be mailed to the STATE COLLECTIONS AND DISBURSEMENT UNIT (SCaDU), P.O. BOX 98950, LAS VEGAS, NV 89193-8950.
