ORDER FOR ISSUANCE OF LETTERS OF SPECIAL ADMINISTRATION

THIS MATTER was brought on before the Court on the 11th day of September, 2006, on the Verified Petition for Letters of Special Administration with Will/Trust Annexed. Present in Court were the Petitioner, FREDRIC C. STODIECK, together with his counsel, MICHAEL SMILEY ROWE, ESQ. of ROWE & HALES, LLP.

Based upon the Verified Petition for Letters of Special Administration with Will/Trust Annexed, and good cause appearing:

IT IS HEREBY FOUND, CONCLUDED AND ORDERED as follows:

- 1. The Court finds that WILLIAM R.R. STODIECK ("Decedent") died on May 15, 2005. The Court has been provided with a certified copy of the Decedent's Death Certificate. The Decedent was born on August 19, 1912, and had been assigned Social Security Number 6157.
- 2. The Court finds that the Petitioner is currently serving as the Successor Co-Trustee of the William R.R. Stodieck Trust Agreement u.t.d. April 22, 2005.

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- 3. The Decedent duly and properly executed a Will on April 22, 2005. The Decedent nominated the Petitioner as his Personal Representative (Executor).
- 4. The Court finds that the beneficiaries and distributees of the Trust have been provided with due and proper notice of the hearing; Notice of Hearing being filed with the Court on the 16th day of August, 2006.
- 5. Petitioner has alleged, and the Court so finds, that Petitioner, as Successor Trustee, would not normally petition this Court for assistance in the administration of the Trust. However, Petitioner has brought his Petition pursuant to NRS 164.015(4) for the Court's assistance in the transfer of certain assets from the Decedent's name to the Trust. The Court takes cognizance of the Petition and the referenced statute, and hereby grants Petitioner the Court's advice and instructions, and assistance in the administration of the Trust.
- 6. The Court finds and concludes that good cause exists for the appointment of a Special Administrator, in this case the Petitioner, to assist in the transfer of the Decedent's assets to the Trust of the Decedent.

ORDER

- 1. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, based upon the above and foregoing findings and conclusions, that the Petitioner, FREDRIC C. STODIECK shall be appointed as the Special Administrator of the Estate of WILLIAM R.R. STODIECK, Deceased, pursuant to the provisions of NRS 140.010, NRS 164.015 and/or NRS 164.030.
- 2. **BE IT FURTHER ORDERED** that the Petitioner is appointed as the Special Administrator of this estate for the purpose of

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transferring all οf the Decedent's assets Petitioner to the Successor Co-Trustee of the Decedent's Trust be administered pursuant to the terms of the Trust Agreement.

- 3. BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of this Court shall issue letters of Special Administration to FREDRIC C. STODIECK, Special Administrator, for the purposes herein authorized. shall be required of the Petitioner to serve as Special Administrator of the Decedent's estate.
- 4. BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that upon completion of the transfer of the assets, Petitioner may request that the Court enter an order without hearing terminating the Special Administration, and honorably discharging the Petitioner from any further duties or requirements as Special Administrator. The Court shall not require an accounting of the Special Administrator at the time of termination of the special administration, but Petitioner shall provide satisfactory evidence to the Court, as exhibits to his request to terminate the administration, of successful transfer of the the assets of the Decedent the Decedent's Trust. to
