THIS MATTER came before the Court at a hearing on the 14th day of April, 2008. Present in court was James R. Hales, Esq., of Rowe & Hales, LLP and Petitioner Marsha Tomerlin. Good cause existing this Court finds and orders as follows:

- 1. Marjorie Dewey was, at the time of her death, a resident of Douglas County, Nevada.

 Ms. Dewey was predeceased by her parents and had no children.
 - 2. Petitioner Marsha L. Tomerlin is a current resident of Douglas County, Nevada.
- 3. Prior to her death, Marjorie L. Dewey created the Marjorie L. Dewey Revocable Trust. The Trust was originally created on March 23, 1984. It was amended five times between its creation and May 8, 2003. On March 28, 2005 the trust was amended entirely and restated. The written trust document was thus titled "The Sixth Trust Amendment to the Marjorie L. Dewey Revocable Trust" which provided that upon Marjorie L. Dewey's passing, Marsha L. Tomerlin is to serve as Successor Trustee.
- 4. The Trust provides that five separate \$10,000 distributions are to be made to five different individuals, and that the household goods, furniture, etc. are to be distributed equally between Suzaine Williams and Suzette McPhail. The residual of the Trust is then to be divided equally between Suzaine Williams and Suzette McPhail if they both survive the trustor by 90 days.

///

- 5. Substantial evidence exists that prior to her death Marjorie Dewey desired to amend her trust to make the following distributions:
 - (1) Tom Corliss \$25,000
 - (2) Lucy Corliss \$25,000
 - (3) Sandy Quezada \$5,000
 - (4) Marsha Tomerlin \$25,000 (to be used for the care of Ms. Dewey's two dogs, Jak and Jil)
- 6. Ms. Dewey retained Mr. James R. Hales of Rowe & Hales for the purpose of amending her trust and provided to Mr. Hales during at a meeting at her home, a written document which set forth her desires. Though Mr. Hales was diligent in his efforts to amend the trust to effectuate the desires of Ms. Dewey before her passing, her demise was so rapid that it was not possible for Mr. Hales to complete the tasks for which Ms. Dewey had retained him.
- 7. There is no dispute by any beneficiary of the Trust as to what Ms. Dewey's desires were, or that she was competent to express these desires when she met with Mr. Hales on February 8, 2008. In fact, both Suzaine Williams and Suzette McPhail have filed Consents with the Court approving of the requested instruction.
- 8. Though the Trust was not amended pursuant to the standard imposed by Article 1, Section 1.02(B) (page 3) which allows for the Trust to be amended during the lifetime of the Grantor but that any Amendments are to be in writing and signed by the Grantor, the Court finds that the intent of the Grantor is clear and that the beneficiaries approve of the proposed amended distribution.
- 9. In a written agreement dated April 2, 2005, signed by Marjorie L. Dewey, she specifically requested that Marsha Tomerlin sell the house. Marsha Tomerlin is a licensed real estate broker in the State of Nevada. It is clear that Ms. Dewey desired that Marsha Tomerlin function not just as trustee, but also as the listing broker for the sale of the home, and as such would be entitled to receive a standard broker's commission on the sale.
