WITNESSED

Whereas, on November 3, 2006, Douglas County, a political subdivision of the State of Nevada, and HDR Engineering, Inc. (HDR), an independent contractor, entered into a contract for certain services for design of Phase II Improvements to increase the capacity of the North Valley Wastewater Treatment Facility to 1.0 million gallons per day (mgd); and

Whereas, the design of the improvements, as defined in the original scope of work, was completed to a 90 percent level; and

Whereas, due to budget constraints (as discussed in a meeting on April 8, 2008, with Carl Ruschmeyer and Ron Roman), the County decided to construct an interim project of reduced scope to bring the capacity of the North Valley Wastewater Treatment Facility to 0.5 mgd. The following elements were included:

- Modifications to the existing biotower pumping station, which included installation of new submersible pumps.
- Connection of the existing Distribution Box No. 1 to the existing biotower pumping station wet well.
- New 18-inch-diameter piping between the existing biotower outlet box and biotower pumping station wet well.
- New 14- and 18-inch-diameter piping between the biotower outlet box and new flow diversion structure.
- Reinforced concrete flow diversion structure.
- New 12- and 14-inch-diameter piping between the flow diversion structure and the existing Biolac pond and Pond No. 5.
- Raising the level of existing Biolac pond by one foot (including level in existing chlorine contact basin); and

Whereas, in August 2008, the County decided to add odor control facilities to the existing headworks and existing biotower, and install a geomembrane liner in Pond No. 4. This project

became defined as the North Valley Wastewater Treatment Facility Phase IIA Improvements Project. Bidding documents were prepared by HDR, and bids were received by the County on October 18, 2008; and

Now, therefore, in consideration of the agreements herein made, the parties mutually agree as follows:

- Amend Scope of Services, as described in Exhibit B attached. This scope of work includes bidding and construction services for construction of the North Valley Wastewater Treatment Facility Phase IIA Improvements Project.
- Incorporate Exhibit C Schedule attached.
- Total extra fee is \$58,854, as shown in Exhibit D attached.
- All other sections of the original agreement remain in effect.

TASK 4 - BIDDING SERVICES

Subtask 4.1 - Services During Bidding

CONSULTANT will conduct prebid meeting, review bids, and recommend award for construction. CONSULTANT will issue up to one addendum during the bidding phase.

Deliverables: Written addenda and/or clarifications to contract documents, written evaluation, and summary of bids.

TASK 5 - CONSTRUCTION SERVICES

Subtask 5.1 – Preconstruction Conference

CONSULTANT will attend a preconstruction conference for the project.

Deliverables: None.

Subtask 5.2 – Submittal Review

CONSULTANT will review up to 30 submittals for the project, as requested by the County.

Deliverables: Written evaluation and recommended action on shop drawings.

Subtask 5.3 – On-Call Construction Services

CONSULTANT will provide on-call construction services, as requested by the County, based on time and expenses, and in accordance with the hourly billing rates in the contract compensation schedule, for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$20,000. Construction services may include reviewing construction issues, conducting periodic site visits, and providing technical support as requested.

Deliverables: As negotiated.

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Subtask 5.4 - Record Drawings

CONSULTANT will prepare record drawings based on construction information provided by the County.

Deliverables: One full-size (22" x 34") set of record drawings on bond, one CD containing

construction record drawings in AutoCAD format, and one CD containing

construction record drawings in PDF format.
