Whereas, on October 11, 2007, Douglas County, a political subdivision of the State of Nevada (COUNTY), and RO Anderson, an independent contractor (INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR), entered into a contract to prepare a Letter of Map Revision (LOMR) and a Conditional Letter of Map Revision (CLOMR) for the Martin Slough (CONTRACT); and

Whereas, the LOMR was submitted to FEMA for comments and in response FEMA is now requiring additional hydraulic encroachment analyses and a floodway to be identified in the Martin Slough.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the agreements herein made, the parties mutually agree to amend the Contract as follows:

Scope of Services and Fee Proposal for Contract Amendment No. 4 Floodway Analysis of Martin Slough

Dear Mahmood:

The purpose of this letter is to convey our proposed scope of services and fee proposal to accomplish a floodway analysis for the reach of Martin Slough from Stockyard Road to Toler Avenue. This is a supplemental task to the existing contract for the flood hydraulics study of Martin Slough that is currently in progress.

Based on the review comments from FEMA, establishment of a floodway for the study reach of Martin Slough is required. This occurred because portions of the study reach of Martin Slough experienced sufficient floodplain-fringe encroachment from historic development to exceed the allowable increase of 1.0 ft in Base Flood Elevation (BFE). As a result, those portions of the study reach are out of compliance with National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) regulations. Therefore, FEMA is requiring establishment of a floodway along the study reach of Martin Slough.

We offer the following scope of services and fee proposal.

Task 8: Floodway Analysis. The purpose of this task is to use (and update) the Existing Conditions Model (ECM) already developed for the on-going flood hydraulics study to develop a regulatory floodway. The technical approach is to use the interpolated BFEs from the Effective Model at each Existing Conditions Model cross section to determine the allowable rise, not to exceed 1.0 ft greater than the original (1982 Effective Model) Base Flood Elevation. This is an iterative approach wherein adjustments are made to each cross section, the model (computer program HEC-RAS) is operated, and the impact on the changed cross section and adjacent cross sections in the encroached ECM are examined for changes in water-surface elevation. The process is continued cross section by cross

section until the floodway boundary for all cross sections in the encroached ECM is determined.

With completion of the floodway analysis, our report in support of the application for a Letter of Map Revision will be revised to include results from the alternative mitigation project analyses, floodway analysis, updated exhibits, and the MT-2 application for FEMA submission for Douglas County review and submission to FEMA.

It is anticipated that meetings between Dr. Thompson and Douglas County personnel will occur approximately every two weeks through project completion.

The time required to complete this work and supply updated results for Douglas County review is forty-five (45) days from notice to proceed.

Proposed Fee: \$12,950.
