WHEREAS, on 17th February, 2007, Douglas County, a political subdivision of the State of Nevada ("COUNTY"), and Nichols Consulting Engineers, Chtd. Dear Mr. Azad.

Per our October 21, 2010 and November 30, 2010 meetings, Nichols Consulting Engineers (NCE) is pleased to submit this request for Contract Amendment #5 associated with the Lake Village Phase II Water Quality Improvement Project (WQIP). If approved, Amendment #5 will authorize NCE to carry out the following tasks:

- Prepare Construction Drawings and Specifications for the resolution of known utility conflicts within the project area (see Tasks 16a-16d, below);
- Prepare a Technical Memorandum that presents the detention times for the 1, 2, 5, 10, 25 and 100 year events in Basins #1 and #3, and if determined necessary by Douglas County, the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC), and NCE, adjust the orifice schedule for each outlet structure (see Task 16e, below); and
- 3. Provide construction assistance during the 2011 construction season (see Task 16f, below).

Task 16 - Construction Support

Amend this task to include the following subtasks:

Task 16a:

Utility Plan Submittal for Douglas County Review:

Under this task, NCE will prepare/submit preliminary plans and construction specifications for the resolution of known utility conflicts (water/sewer) for review by Douglas County-Engineering Division. Known utility conflicts exist in the vicinity of Basin #1, SV-1, Basin #4, and at SF-3. The Preliminary Plans will be based on potholing information provided by PEEK Construction, design concepts discussed during 10/21/10 meeting with Douglas County-Engineering Division staff, and the topographic information, property lines, right-of-way, and proposed improvements set forth in the final construction drawings for the Lake Village Phase II Water Quality Improvement Project. It is anticipated that the preliminary plans for the resolution of known utility conflicts will consist of two (2) plan sheets, and one (1) detail sheet. The plan sheets will delineate revised horizontal layouts and callouts for storm drain facilities in the vicinity of Basin #1, SV-1, Basin #4, and SF-3. The detail sheet will include construction details for water/storm drain crossings and other details as necessitated by the proposed design. NCE will submit the plans to Douglas County in digital form (pdf), as 11" x 17" sheets. NCE will prepare/submit construction specifications as necessitated by the preliminary plans. NCE will submit the preliminary specifications to Douglas County staff in digital form (pdf).

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Task 16b:

Utility Plan Submittal for Agency Review:

Under this task, NCE will address comments provided by Douglas County-Engineering Division on the utility plans and construction specifications provided under Task 16a. NCE will then prepare a revised set of plans and specifications for review by Douglas County-Engineering Division, Nevada Department of Environmental Protection (NDEP), and the Kingsbury General Improvement District (KGID). NCE will submit the revised plans and specifications to Douglas County, NDEP, and KGID in digital form (pdf), as 11" x 17" sheets. NCE will submit the revised specifications to Douglas County, NDEP, and KGID in digital form (pdf).

Task 16c:

Final Utility Plan Submittal:

Under this task, NCE will address comments provided by Douglas County-Engineering Division, NDEP, and KGID on the plans and specifications provided under Task 16b. NCE will then prepare a final set of plans and specifications for the resolution of known utility conflicts to Douglas County-Engineering Division, NDEP, and KGID. NCE will submit one full-size (24" x 36") reproducible plan set to Douglas County-Engineering Division, and a digital copy to NDEP and KGID. NCE will submit one camera ready copy of the final specifications to Douglas County and a digital copy to NDEP and KGID.

Task 16d:

Provide General Coordination for Resolution of Utility Conflicts:

Under this task, NCE will coordinate with Douglas County-Engineering Division, NDEP, and KGID in developing the plans, details, and construction specifications for the resolution of known utility conflicts.

Task 16e:

Prepare Technical Memorandum Regarding Detention Times and Provide Redesign:

Under this task, NCE will prepare a brief memorandum that presents the detention times for the 1, 2, 5, 10, 25 and 100 year events in Basins #1 and #3. If after reviewing the detention times, Douglas County-Engineering Division, the TAC, and NCE determine it appropriate to adjust the orifice schedule, NCE will adjust the orifice schedule accordingly (this assumes the adjustment to the orifice schedule does not require any changes to the design plans, drainage report, and/or hydraulic analysis). If Douglas County and/or the TAC determine significant changes are required, NCE will develop a separate scope of work to revise the plans, drainage report, and/or hydraulic analysis. This task also includes preparation for, and participation in, one (1) three-hour meeting with Douglas County and the TAC to discuss the above-mentioned memorandum.

Task 16f:

Provide Construction Assistance During the 2011 Construction Season:

Under this task, NCE will be available for 8-10 hours per week during the 2011 construction season (May 1-October 15) to assist County staff in responding to Contractor Requests for Information (RFI), reviewing proposed Change Orders, and to attend miscellaneous field meetings with the Contractor (including Contractor's pre-construction meeting), utility companies, project stakeholders, and the TRPA (including TRPA's 2011 pre-grade meeting). Douglas County will be responsible for coordinating the Contractor's pre-construction meeting and TRPA's 2011 pre-grade meeting. This task assumes that construction assistance would be required for no more than 10 hours per week for 23 weeks. Also under this task, NCE will provide monthly project status reports to summarize the work completed during the previous billing period.
