WHEREAS, Douglas County, a political subdivision of the State of Nevada, presently holds a strip of land, situated within the Southwest ¼ of Section 29, Township 13 North, Range 20 East, M.D.M., Douglas County, State of Nevada, further described as a portion of the Right-of-Way known as 8th Street as shown on that Record of Survey, File No. 86414, Book 983, Page 101, and further reconfigured by Document Nos. 108772 and 115887, Official Records of Douglas County, Nevada, and as more particularly described and depicted in the attached Legal Description and Abandonment Exhibit provided as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, Douglas County, pursuant to the provisions of NRS 278.480, may vacate or abandon by formal order any portion a public right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, On March 3, 2011, the Douglas County Board of Commissioners held a public hearing in conformance with the provisions of NRS 278.240 to take testimony for said abandonment and did find that the release of the aforesaid public right-of-way is in excess of the needs of Douglas County and that the public will not be materially injured by the abandonment; and


