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ORDER APPROVING FIRST ACCOUNT AND REPORT OF EXECUTOR, APPROVING ADMINISTRATIVE FEES AND COSTS, AND ORDERING PARTIAL DISTRIBUTION

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WENDY M. NAVELLIER, Executor of the estate of STANLEY PETER

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place of the previously requested One Million Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollar

(\$1,250,000) reserve. The Court now finds as follows:

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- 1. Notice of the Hearing on the Petition has been regularly given as prescribed by law. The Petitioner and the beneficiary of the Estate have waived Notice of the oral amendments made at the hearing.
 - 2. That said account is in all respects true and correct.
- 3. The Executor caused to be duly published a Notice to Creditors for the period and in the manner prescribed by law, and after the completion of publication there was filed with the Clerk of the Court an affidavit showing due publication of notice in the manner and form prescribed by law. Notice to Creditors was filed on November 23, 2011, and published in the Record-Courier on December 2, 7, and 14, 2011. A Proof and Statement of Publication of the Notice to Creditors was filed on February 7, 2012. Mailing of the Notice to Creditors was completed on November 28, 2011, with an Affidavit of Mailing filed on November 29, 2011. A Notice of Executor's Action on Filed Claims was filed on March 23, 2012. More than ninety (90) days have elapsed since the first publication of Notice to Creditors on December 2, 2011, and the time for filing or presenting claims has expired in accordance with the provisions of NRS 147.010, et seq.
- An Inventory, Appraisement and Record of Value was filed herein on February 1, 2012, setting the value of the Decedent's one-half (1/2) interest in the community property in the probate estate, as of March 14, 2011, the date of death, in the sum of Five Million Six Hundred Ninety-three Thousand Six Hundred Thirty-seven Dollars (\$5,693,637). The Inventory and Record of Value lists all of the assets of the Decedent's estate subject to probate which are known to Executor, and which have come into her possession.
- The Executor has requested that the contingency reserve fund in the sum of One Million Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$1,250,000) set out in the Petition not be retained. Rather, the Executor requests a contingency reserve of Five Hundred Thousand



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Dollars (\$500,000) consisting of the Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000) paid by the Estate to the U.S. Treasury with the request for extension of time to file the estate tax return of the Decedent and One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) to be retained in the Estate The Executor further proposes to post a bond in favor of the IRS to secure any potential federal estate taxes arising out of the Qualified Domestic Trust and to provide evidence of the posting of said bond with the Court. The requested Five Hundred Thousand Dollar (\$500,000) contingency reserve appears to be sufficient to cover foreseeable contingencies such that the requested partial distribution may be made without injury to creditors of the estate, therefore the posting of a bond is not necessary.

The Executor contends that the Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000) paid in to the U.S. Treasury with the request for extension of time to file the estate tax return of the Decedent, together with the retention of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) in the Estate account, and the bond the Executor plans to post in connection with the creation of the Qualified Domestic Trust, makes the previously prayed for retention of \$1,250,000 unnecessary.

- Wendy M. Navellier, in her capacity as Executor has requested 6. approval of ordinary Executor's fee in the amount of Two Hundred Forty-two Thousand, One Hundred Fifty-one Dollars (\$242,151).
- Michael S. Gregg, A Professional Corporation, Attorney for the 7. Executor, has rendered services to the Executor and the Estate, and has requested approval of statutory attorney's fees as set forth in NRS Section 150.060 of the Nevada Revised Statutes, in the amount of One Hundred Twenty-four Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty-one Dollars (\$124,961), and reimbursement of costs in the amount of Two Thousand Six Hundred Three

Dollars (\$2,603), for a total of One Hundred Twenty-seven Thousand Five Hundred Sixty-four Dollars (\$127,564).

8. Decedent's Will dated February 16, 2011, leaves his estate to his surviving spouse, Mary Millan.

Based upon the foregoing, the Court orders the following:

- A. The first account and report of the Executor as to the administration of the Estate of STANLEY PETER MILLAN a/k/a STAN P. MILLAN, Decedent, is hereby settled, allowed and approved.
- B. All acts and transactions of the Executor as disclosed in the First Account is confirmed and approved, including the sale of volatile securities.
- C. The Executor is authorized and directed to pay Wendy M. Navellier, the Executor for the estate, the sum of Two Hundred Forty-two Thousand, One Hundred Fifty-one Dollars (\$242,151) as compensation for Executor services rendered during the administration of the estate.
- D. The Executor is authorized and directed to pay the law firm of Michael S. Gregg, A Professional Corporation, attorney for the estate, the sum of One Hundred Twenty-seven Thousand Five Hundred Sixty-four Dollars (\$127,564) as reasonable compensation for legal services rendered during the administration of the estate and for reimbursement of costs.
- E. The Executor is authorized and directed to distribute all the estate's interest in the real property located in Zephyr Cove, Douglas County, Nevada, commonly known as 1069 Skyland Drive, Zephyr Cove, Nevada, , APN: 1318-03-110-028, and more particularly described as follows:

The Four Hundred Thousand Dollar (\$400,000) sum paid into the U.S. Treasury by the Estate, together with the retention of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) in the Estate account, and the bond the Executor is to post in connection with the creation of the Qualified Domestic Trust constitutes a sufficient contingency reserve to provide for additional administrative expenses and taxes such that the requested distribution may be made without injury to creditors of the Estate, therefore the posting of a bond in the estate is not necessary.
