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

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THIS CAUSE comes before the above-entitled Court upon the petition of George M. Keele, A Professional Corporation, as counsel to Sharon Ehrig and Donald Swierstra, Conservators of Shirley Prater in Case No. CONPS-1100304 in the Superior Court of California, County of San Bernardino, IN RE: THE MATTER OF THE CONSERVATORSHIP OF SHIRLEY PRATER.

Having reviewed the Petition, and being fully advised in the premises, the Court finds as follows:

1. The instant Case No. 11-PB-0089 in this Department No. 2 in the Ninth Judicial District Court of the State of Nevada in and for the County of Douglas began as a guardianship of the person and estate of SHIRLEY PRATER, who



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is the same SHIRLEY PRATER named as the Conservatee in Superior Court of California, County of San Bernardino, Case No. CONPS-1100304.

2. The said Conservatee, SHIRLEY PRATER, has recently moved to California, leaving an improved parcel of real property ("the Parcel") in the state of Nevada, commonly known as 865 Longleaf Place, Minden, Douglas County, Nevada 89423. The legal description of the Parcel is as follows:

LOT 5 IN BLOCK D AS SET FORTH ON FINAL MAP OF WESTWOOD VILLAGE UNIT NO. III FILED IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY RECORDER OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, STATE OF NEVADA, ON AUGUST 31, 1989, IN BOOK 889, PAGE 4564, AS DOCUMENT NO. 209883.

Assessor's Parcel No. 1320-30-311-030.

Upon removing to California, SHIRLEY PRATER became 3. the Conservatee in Case No. CONPS-1100304 in Superior Court San Bernardino, whereupon, County of of California, instant Court, namely: Department II of the Ninth Judicial District of the State of Nevada in and for the County of Douglas, entered its provisional (see NRS 159.2024(2)) Order Jurisdiction this of Petition to Transfer Approving guardianship proceeding to the Superior Court of California, PS-1100304, Bernardino, in Case No. CON County of San reserving such jurisdiction as may be necessary to resolve all matters pertinent to the Nevada guardianship of estate of SHIRLEY PRATER, an adult ward, such guardianship



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of the ward's estate not yet having been terminated (see generally NRS 159.2024). For this Honorable Court to consider and enter an order dealing with the instant Petition is a matter that remains within the jurisdiction of this Court.

4. The names and post office addresses of the Conservators in the above-entitled California Superior Court conservatorship are as follows:

SHARON EHRIG, 2716 Whirlaway Street, Alta Loma, CA 91737 DONALD SWIERSTRA, 8345 Pacerway, Riverside, CA 92509.

5. On August 13, 2012, the Superior Court of California, County of San Bernardino, in Case No. CONPS-1100304, entered its Order Confirming Sale of Real Property in which it found, among other things, that:

- 2. All notices required by law were given and, if required, proof of notice of sale was made.
- 3. b. Good reason existed for the sale of the property commonly described as 865 Longleaf Place, Minden, Nevada 89423.
- 4. The sale was legally made and fairly conducted.
- 5. The confirmed sale price is not disproportionate to the value of the property.
- 6. Private sale: The amount bid is 90% or more of the appraised value of the property as appraised within one year of the date of the hearing.
 - 7. *** N/A
- 8. The conservator of the estate of the decedent, conservatee, or minor has made reasonable efforts to obtain the highest and best price reasonably attainable for the property.



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The California Superior Court, among other things, 6. 1 ordered as follows: 2 The sale of the real property legally 9. 3 described [as the Parcel] is confirmed to ERNEST J. WURSCHUM AND JANICE M. WURSCHUM, HUSBAND AND sale price of the for TENANTS JOINT AS 5 \$229,000 * * * on terms set forth in the purchase agreement between the 6 7 Conservators and Ernest J. Wurschum and Janice M. Wurschum, 8 as purchasers of the Parcel. 9 Conservators 2012, the 30, August 10 California Superior Court Case No. CONPS-1100304 registered 11 the above-referenced August 13, 2012, Order Confirming Sale 12 of Real Property in the instant Douglas County, Nevada, 13 14 District Court Case No. 11-PB-0089, by filing in the instant 15 Court the following documents, pursuant to section 159.2025 16 of the Nevada Revised Statutes ("NRS"): 17 Certified copies of the California Superior 18 19 Court order and letters of office; and 20 Copies of the guardians' drivers' licenses in 21 a sealed envelope. 22 The provisions of subsection 1 of NRS 17.360 read 23 as follows: 24 the time of the filing of the foreign 25 judgment, the judgment creditor or the judgment creditor's attorney shall file with the clerk of 26 the court an affidavit setting forth the name and last known post office address of the judgment 27 debtor and the judgment creditor. The affidavit

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must also include a statement that the foreign judgment is valid and enforceable, and the extent to which it has been satisfied.

This Court finds that there is no judgment creditor nor judgment creditor's attorney in California Superior Court Case No. CONPS-1100304; therefore, the law does not require the judgment creditor or the judgment creditor's attorney to file with the clerk of this court an affidavit as required by subsection 1 of NRS 17.360; therefore, the provisions of subsection 1 of NRS 17.360 do not apply in the instant case.

- 9. The provisions of subsections 2 and 3 of NRS 17.360 read as follows:
 - foreign filing the upon Promptly judgment and affidavit, the judgment creditor or someone on behalf of the judgment creditor shall mail notice of the filing of the judgment and affidavit, attaching a copy of each to the notice, judgment debtor and to the debtor's attorney of record, if any, each at his last known address by certified mail, her return receipt requested. The notice shall include the name and post office address of the judgment creditor and the judgment creditor's attorney, if in this state. The judgment creditor shall file with the clerk of the court an affidavit setting forth the date upon which the notice was mailed.
 - 3. No execution or other process for enforcement of a foreign judgment may issue until 30 days after the date of mailing the notice of filing.

Court finds and concludes that, because there no judgment creditor's attorney; no judgment no creditor; debtor's attorney in judgment no judgment debtor; and



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California Superior Court Case No. CONPS-1100304, the provisions of subsections 2 and 3 of NRS 17.360 do not apply in the instant case.

10. Based upon these findings and conclusions, the provisions of NRS 17.350, which read as follows:

An exemplified copy of any foreign judgment may be filed with the clerk of any district court of this state. The clerk shall treat the foreign judgment in the same manner as a judgment of the district court of this state. A judgment so filed has the same effect and is subject to the same procedures, defenses and proceedings for reopening, vacating or staying as a judgment of a district court of this state and may be enforced or satisfied in like manner.

are fully effective from the entry of the instant Order.

the ORDERED HEREBY IS IT THEREFORE, NOW. Confirming Sale of Order of the exemplified copy in California Superior 13, 2012, Property entered August CONPS-1100304 No. Case County, Bernardino San Court, (hereinafter "California Superior Court" Order in Case No. CONPS-1100304"), having been filed with the Clerk of this Ninth Judicial District Court of the State of Nevada in and Douglas, the said California Superior for the County of Court Order in Case No. CONPS-1100304 shall be treated by the Clerk in the same manner as a judgment of this or any i.e. the state of this state, other district court of Nevada.

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AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the escrow pertaining to the Parcel that is currently pending closing of escrow in the state of Nevada, in which Ernest J. Wurschum and Janice M. Wurschum are the buyers and the above-named Conservators of SHIRLEY PRATER are the sellers, may close forthwith, in accordance with the provisions of the purchase agreement and escrow instructions between the Conservators of SHIRLEY PRATER, as seller, and the Wurschums, as buyers.
