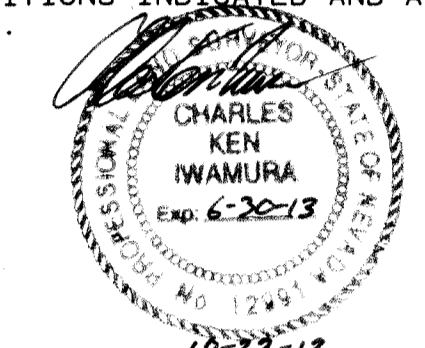

VICINITY MAP

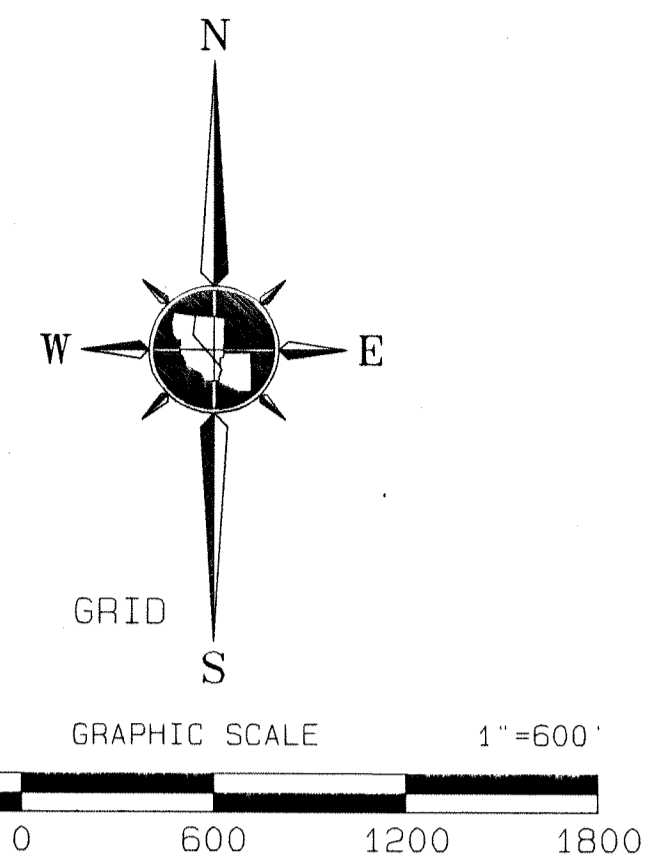

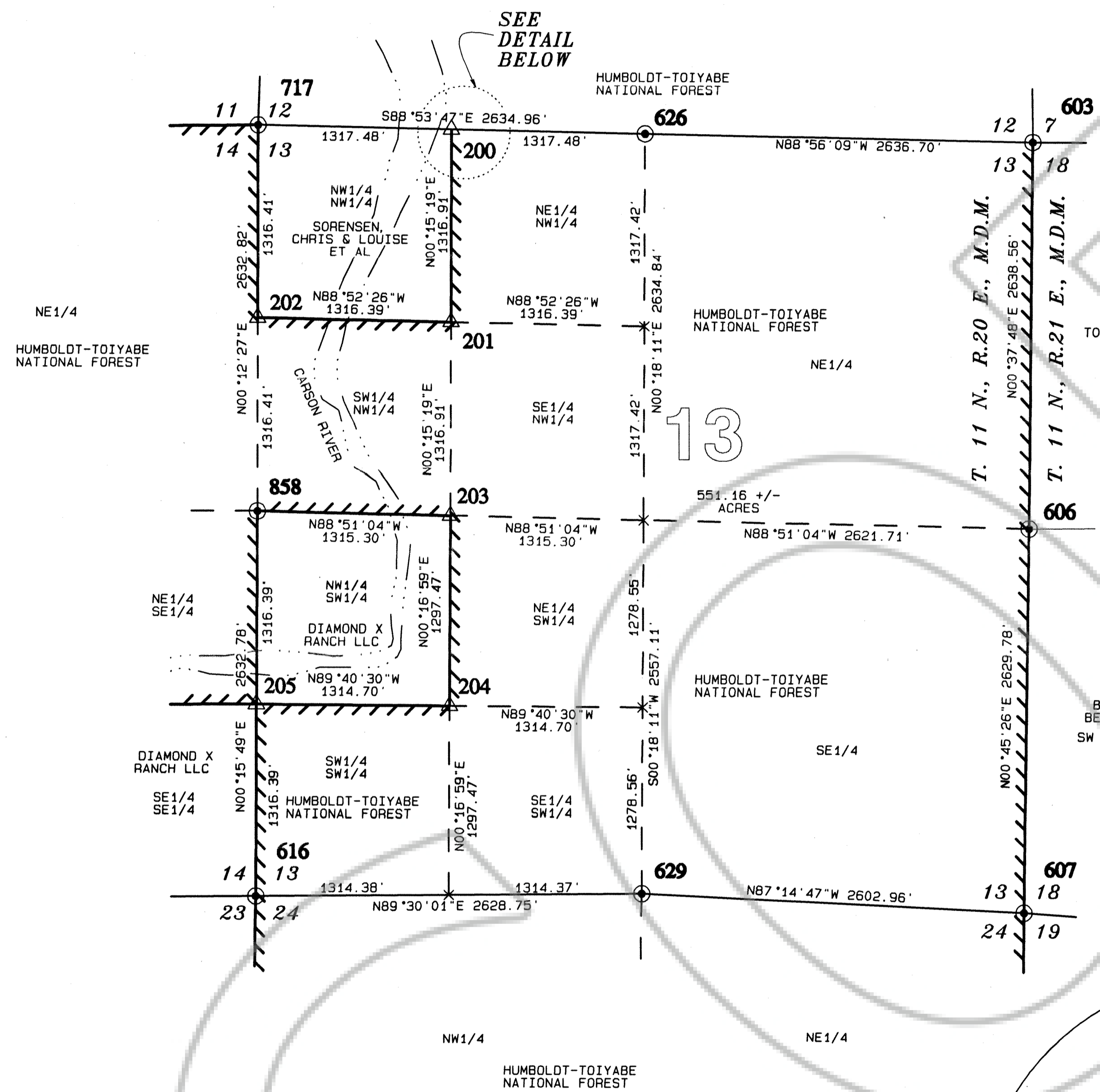

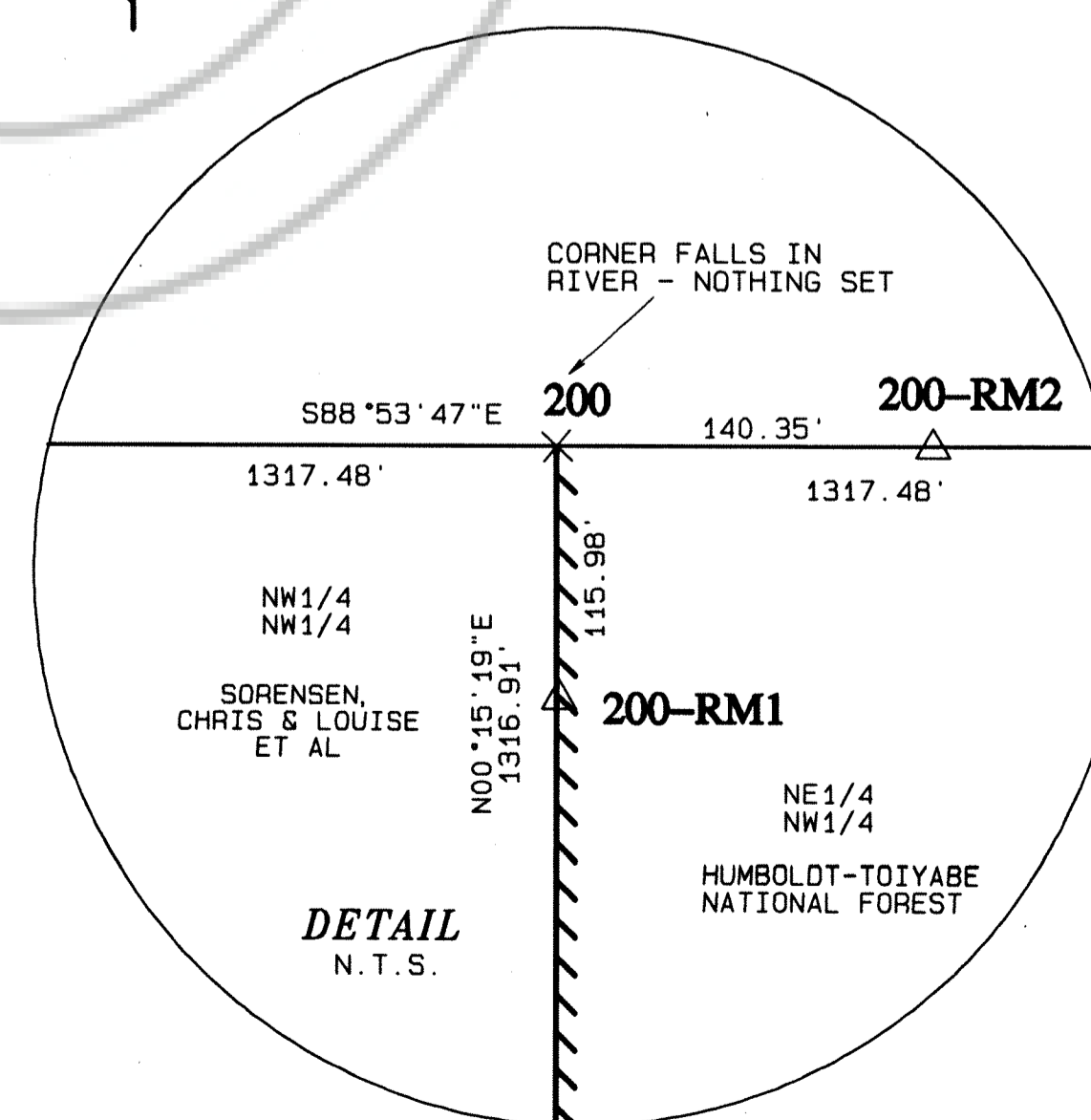
