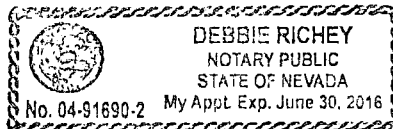

After considering all of the evidence, the Master hereby makes the following Findings and Recommendations:

The Obligor was properly served on AUGUST 6, 2015, with a Notice and Finding of Financial and Responsibility.

1 Obligor is the father of ATHENA GRIBBIN, born JUNE 7, 2005 and IZABELLA
2 GRIBBIN, born NOVEMBER 22, 2007.

- 3 Obligee was properly noticed of today's hearing on or about DECEMBER 17, 2015.
4 Obligor's gross monthly earnings are \$1,864.00. Pursuant to the formula prescribed
5 within NRS 125B.070, 25% of those earnings, the state calculates a support obligation
6 in the sum of \$466.00. Gross monthly income based on actual earnings.

7 THE RECOMMENDED ORDER:

- 8 1. The Obligor shall pay \$466.00 per month in ongoing support beginning
9 FEBRUARY 1, 2016. The obligation for Child Support continues until the child turns
10 18 years of age, or until the child turns 19 years of age if the child is enrolled in High
11 School. However, this obligation to support a child is affected by a child's ability to
12 live on their own (NRS129.080 to 129.140 – legal emancipation) or when applicable,
13 continued financial support beyond the age of majority per NRS 125B.110.
14 2. An arrears Judgment is entered in the amount of \$3,765.00 for MARCH 1, 2015
15 through JANUARY 31, 2016.
16 To be paid by payments of \$30.00 per month beginning FEBRUARY 1, 2016.

17 All payments MUST be made in the form of a money order, cashier's check or business check
18 and payable to **STATE COLLECTION AND DISBURSEMENT UNIT (SCaDU)** and sent
19 to:

23 The following information must be included with each payment:

- 24 A. Name (first, middle, last) of person responsible for paying child support.
25 B. Social Security Number of person responsible for paying child support.
26 C. Child support case number 397-83-2100A listed on each payment.
27 D. Name of custodian (first and last name of person receiving child support).

28 **PAYMENT OF SUPPORT IS TO BE AS PROVIDED HEREIN, AND THE GIVING OF
GIFTS, OF MAKING PURCHASES OF FOOD, CLOTHING AND THE LIKE WILL**

1 NOT FULFILL THE OBLIGATION. NOTICE: NO CREDIT WILL BE GIVEN FOR
2 PAYMENTS PAID DIRECTLY TO THE OBLIGEE.

3 3. All payments shall be made by immediate income withholding. If your full obligation
4 is not met by the amount withheld by your employer, you are responsible to pay the
5 difference between your court ordered obligation and the amount withheld by your
6 employer directly to the STATE COLLECTION AND DISBURSEMENT UNIT
7 (SCaDU). If you fail to do so you will be subject to the assessment of penalties and
8 interest. You may avoid these additional costs by making your current child support
9 payments each month.

10 4. The Obligee shall provide health insurance coverage for the children when available
11 through employment or group policy under a plan that is reasonable in cost as defined
12 in NRS 125B.085 and Obligor shall pay \$0.00 per month for health insurance premium
13 (medical cash) effective FEBRUARY 1, 2016. Medical costs incurred for the above-
14 referenced period have not yet been determined. The State's rights to recover said costs
15 are not waived by way of this order.

16 5. Pursuant to NRS 125B.080(7), expenses for health care which are not reimbursed
17 through insurance, including expenses for medical, surgical, dental, orthodontic and
18 optical expenses, must be shared equally by both parents.

19 6. The Obligor shall keep the Division of Welfare and Supportive Services informed of
20 any change regarding current residential and/or mailing address, employment and of
21 access to health insurance coverage in **WRITING** (including health insurance policy
22 information) within 10 days of such change.

23 7. Obligor shall be responsible for ALL child support and judgment payments due.
24 Payment is to be made directly to the STATE COLLECTION AND
25 DISBURSEMENT UNIT (SCaDU). At any time withholding does not occur, Obligor
26 must make voluntary payments to the STATE COLLECTION AND DISBURSEMENT
27 UNIT (SCaDU).
28

- 1 8. Effective July 1, 2004 simple interest will accrue on all adjudicated arrears balances
2 (including payment in lieu of medical insurance) and spousal support balances, for
3 cases with a Nevada controlling order pursuant to NRS 99.040. Interest assessed by a
4 judgment of the court prior to July 1, 2004 will be enforced. Interest on the judgment
5 shall accrue at the rate established by NRS 125B.140(2)(c)(1).
- 6 9. Pursuant to NRS 125B.095, a late fee/penalty of 10% (ten percent) of the unpaid
7 monthly child support amount will be added to the arrears balance of the Obligor if the
8 Obligor becomes delinquent in the amount owed for one month's support.
- 9 10. The State of Nevada has continuing exclusive jurisdiction for enforcement and
10 modification purposes pursuant to the Full Faith and Credit for Child Support Orders
11 Act.

12 **SUPPORT OBLIGATION BREAKDOWN AS FOLLOWS:**

17 Pursuant to NRS 125B.145 this Order may be reviewed every three (3) years and is subject to
18 future modifications.

19 Unless a stay of this Order is obtained from District Court, all enforcement procedures
20 including, but not limited to wage withholding, garnishment, liens and the attachment of
21 federal income tax returns will be undertaken upon entry of this order.


21 The Court, having reviewed the above and foregoing Master's Report prepared by the Court
