**CONDITIONS, COVENANTS, AND RESTRICTIONS**

PETER A. LYNCH and LYNNE M. LYNCH as Trustees of THE LYNCH FAMILY TRUST, UAD 06/14/1989 (the "Lynch Trust") owns the residence located at 19 Manzanita Court Stateline, Nevada 89449 ("Unit 19"). In October 2007, Unit 17, Unit 18, Unit 19, and Unit 20 (collectively, the "Properties") were destroyed by a fire. The Properties were reconstructed. When the Properties were reconstructed, the Tahoe Douglas Fire Protection District (the "Fire District") required that a fire sprinkler system be installed in the Properties. A fire sprinkler system was installed in the Properties and has experienced leaks. The owners of the Properties allege the fire sprinkler system when installed was defective, and/or unsuitable for the intended use and purpose in numerous ways as a wet system as described in the Fire Engineering report.

For good cause, the Fire District granted the owner of Unit 19 an accommodation for an alternate means of fire protection instead of the wet system. The Fire District requires the existing sprinkler system remain in place, serviceable as a dry system that may be charged and pressurized by the Fire District only in the event of a fire. The system shall have a Fire Department Connection ("FDC") added for responding engines to make the connection and supply water. The FDC location shall be signed with 1 inch letters at an approved readily accessible location. Additionally, the owner of Unit 19 shall have a fire alarm system installed and monitored by a third-party dispatch center. The owner of Unit 19 must register the alarm system with the compliance engine program for the Tahoe Douglas Fire Protection District to ensure the fire alarm coverage is continuously maintained. This document shall be recorded with the Douglas County Recorder's office.

The owner of Unit 19 acknowledges the Fire District will not charge or pressurize the dry fire sprinkler system except during a fire. The integrity of the system under pressure may or may not leak or discharge water in adjoining areas and damage may or may not occur from the use of the system for which the Fire Department will not be held liable should such damage occur. The Lynch Trust and each successor in interest for Unit 19 shall maintain these requirements at all times and in perpetuity unless alleviated from doing so by the Fire District.
