## **Abandonment of Public Utility Easement**

An Order of Abandonment vacating a strip of land utilized for public utility easement purposes located on a parcel owned by Flying Eagle Ranch L.L.C., located within a portion of Section 24, Township 12 North, Range 19 East, Mount Diablo Meridian, Douglas County, Nevada (APN: 1219-24-002-015 & 016).

WHEREAS, Douglas County, a political subdivision of the State of Nevada, presently holds a public utility easement located within a portion of Section 24, Township 12 North, Range 29 East, Mount Diablo Meridian, as depicted on that certain Final Map for Nathan and Cindy Leising recorded September 6, 1995 in the official records of Douglas County, Nevada, in Book 995, Page 492 Document No. 369848, and more particularly described in the attached Legal Description provided and depicted as Exhibit A.

WHEREAS, Douglas County, pursuant to the provisions of Douglas County Code, Section 20.768.060, may vacate or abandon by formal order any portion of a public utility easement owned or controlled by Douglas County; and

WHEREAS, this abandonment request is being made in order to vacate a portion of a public utility easement owned or controlled by Douglas County; and

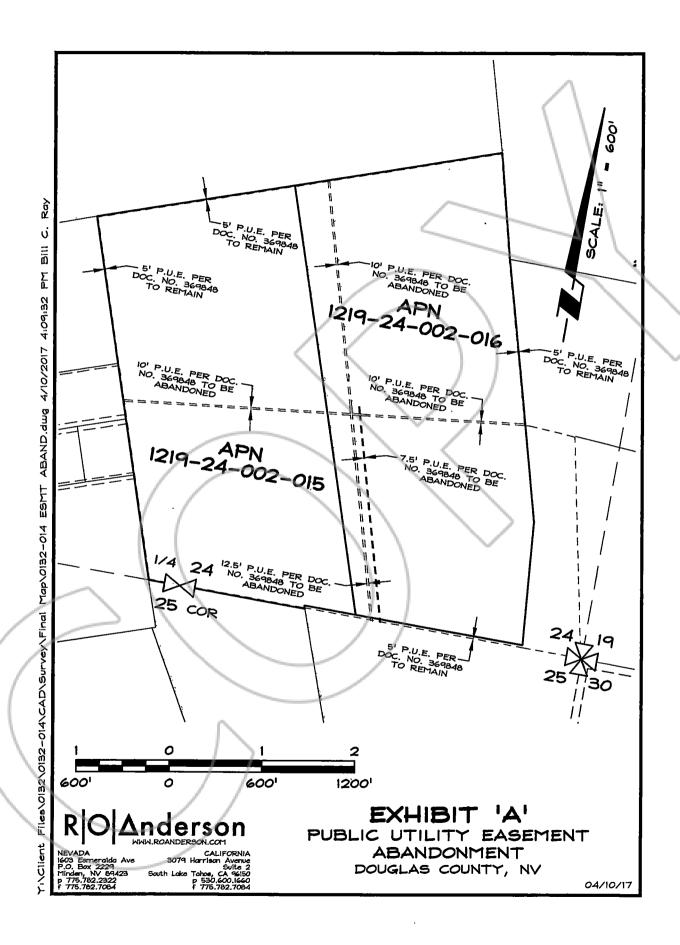
WHEREAS, the Community Development Department obtained written approval from all applicable public utility and video service providers indicating that they no longer request the reservation of the subject easements; and

WHEREAS, on April 11, 2017 the Douglas County Community Development Director determined that the aforesaid easements are no longer necessary or useful to Douglas County and that the public will not be materially injured by the abandonment; and

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordered by the Douglas County Community Development Director, that the aforesaid strip of land utilized for public utility easement way purposes, as described and depicted in the attached description, is hereby abandoned.

Those certain Public Utility Easements described as a 7.5' P.U.E along all road frontages and 5' P.U.E. along all side and rear lines, being:

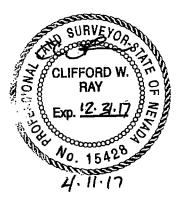
