

This amendment is attached to and made a part of the special use authorization for power lines issued to Sierra Pacific Power Company, dba NV Energy, on November 9, 2012, which is hereby amended to authorize the following:

1. Construction, operation, and maintenance of a new underground power line to serve the Skyland communications site (aka Lincoln Creek). New facilities consist of underground 15kV distribution power line and service conduit (843 feet long by 15 feet wide, .30 acre, 12,945 square feet) and one above-ground transformer. T. 13 N., R. 18 E., sec. 3, APN 1318-03-000-01, Douglas County, NV.
2. Undergrounding of an existing overhead distribution power line and associated improvements at Round Hill Pines Beach Resort. New facilities consist of underground 15kV distribution power line and service conduit (522 feet long by 25 feet wide, 0.30 acre, 13,050 square feet), one transformer, and a metal junction enclosure. T. 13 N., R. 18 E., sec. 15 APN 1318-15-401-001, Douglas County, NV.

Maps showing the locations of the new facilities are attached as Exhibits A and B.

Total area for Skyland and Round Hill Pines Resort underground power lines is 0.60 acre (25,997 square feet).


