FINAL JUDGMENT

This cause having come before the Court and all issues having been duly adjudicated as follows:

1. Bank of the West's Second Amended Complaint

BANK OF THE WEST ("Bank") pled five (5) claims for relief in its Second Amended Complaint.

On March 31, 2017, the Court entered an Order Regarding Motion to Strike and Motion to Dismiss, dismissing the Bank's Third Claim for Relief (Alter Ego – All Defendants).

On December 7, 2017, the Court entered an Order Granting Plaintiff's Motion for Partial Summary Judgment, entering judgment in the Bank's favor and against THE LAKESHORE HOUSE

1 LIMITED PARTNERSHIP ("Lakeshore House") and EMERSON HEDGES, LLC, ("Emerson 2|| Hedges"), jointly and severally, on the Bank's Fifth Claim for Relief (Breach of Contract) in the amount of \$1,800,000.00 plus prejudgment at the legal rate calculated from June 15, 2016,

On April 9, 2018, the Court entered an Order Regarding Motion for Partial Summary Judgment; Motion to Preclude Plaintiff's Expert Witness from Testifying at Trial; Motion to Extend Discovery Deadlines and Continue Trial; Motion to Compel; Motion to Discharge Pre-Judgment Writ of Attachment; Bank of the West's Motion to Stay Discovery Pending Ruling on Motion for Summary Judgment, or, Alternatively, Motion for Protective Order; Motion for Partial Summary Adjudication; Motion to Retax and Deny Costs; Motion for Reconsideration; Rule 56(f) Motion to 10|| Deny or Defer Consideration of BOTW's Motion for Partial Summary Judgment Pending the Conduct of Discovery; Motion for Sanctions; Defendants F. Harvey Whittemore and Annette Whittemore's Motion for Partial Summary Judgment on Bank of the West's First, Second, and Fourth Claims for Relief; Emergency Motion to Stay all Briefing in this Matter; and Ex Parte Application for Order Shortening Time on Emergency Motion to Stay All Briefing in this Matter, dismissing the Bank's First, Second, and Fourth claims for relief as against Lakeshore House and Emerson Hedges.

On September 6, 2018, the Court entered an Order Granting Motion to Voluntarily Dismiss Claims, dismissing the Bank's remaining claims for relief without prejudice.

2. Lakeshore House and Emerson Hedges' First Amended Counterclaim

Lakeshore House and Emerson Hedges pled seven (7) causes of action in their First Amended Counterclaim.

On April 9, 2018, the Court entered an Order Regarding Motion for Partial Summary Judgment; Motion to Preclude Plaintiff's Expert Witness from Testifying at Trial; Motion to Extend Discovery Deadlines and Continue Trial; Motion to Compel; Motion to Discharge Pre-Judgment Writ of Attachment; Bank of the West's Motion to Stay Discovery Pending Ruling on Motion for Summary Judgment, or, Alternatively, Motion for Protective Order; Motion for Partial Summary Adjudication; Motion to Retax and Deny Costs; Motion for Reconsideration; Rule 56(f) Motion to Deny or Defer Consideration of BOTW's Motion for Partial Summary Judgment Pending the Conduct of Discovery; Motion for Sanctions; Defendants F. Harvey Whittemore and Annette

Whittemore's Motion for Partial Summary Judgment on Bank of the West's First, Second, and Fourth Claims for Relief; Emergency Motion to Stay all Briefing in this Matter; and Ex Parte Application for Order Shortening Time on Emergency Motion to Stay All Briefing in this Matter, dismissing each of Lakeshore House and Emerson Hedges' counterclaims against the Bank.

3. Whittemores' First Amended Complaint

F. HARVEY WHITTEMORE and ANNETTE WHITTEMORE, ("the Whittemores") pled two (2) claims for relief in their *First Amended Counterclaim*.

On August 23, 2018, the Court entered an Order Regarding Bank of the West's Motion for Partial Summary Judgment, entering judgment in the Bank's favor and against the Whittemores on the Whittemores' First Claim for Relief (Intentional Infliction of Emotional or Mental Distress).

On August 29, 2018, the parties held a *Status Conference*, at which the parties acknowledged that no justiciable dispute remained to be decided by way of the Whittemores' Second Claim for Relief (Declaratory Relief). The Court previously found that Plaintiff elected not to pursue a breach of contract claim against the Whittemores.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, that judgment is entered in favor of BANK OF THE WEST and against THE LAKESHORE HOUSE LIMITED PARTNERSHIP and EMERSON HEDGES, LLC, jointly and severally, in the amount of \$1,800,000.00, plus prejudgment at the legal rate calculated from June 15, 2016, until paid in full.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
