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Notice to Creditors was given by mail as shown by the Certificates of Mailing on file herein and by publication in the Record Courier, as shown by the proof of publication on file herein.

I

The 90 day period for the submission of Creditors' Claims has expired without the filing of any such claims with the court and without the service of any such claims on the Coexecutors or upon undersigned counsel.

V

The first and final accounting of the estate of the deceased showed that the assets of the estate have been properly marshalled, the debts of the estate have been determined and paid, that such payments should be ratified by the court and and that the estate is now in condition to be distributed.

VI

The Last Will and Testament of the Deceased provided that the estate of the deceased would be distributed as follows:

- 1) All jewelry and items of adornment to REILLY SHEA HOGAN.
- 2) Real property in Duckwater, Nye County, Nevada, to HUNTER JAMES HOGAN. Said real property is described as follows:

Parcel 7415, W 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4, Sec. 5, T.12 N., R. 56 E., M.D.B.&M.

3) Twenty Dollar Gold piece and husband's diamond ring to HUNTER JAMES HOGAN.

4) The rest and residue to be divided into 4 equal shares and distributed one share each to RICHARD HOGAN, TRACY WEST, HUNTER JAMES HOGAN and REILLY SHEA HOGAN.

VII

The will provides that 203 silver dollars and a World War II rifle had been entrusted to RICHARD HOGAN by the deceased and that their value should be deducted from his portion of the distribution if they, or their value, had not been returned to the deceased at the time of her death. Said items or the value thereof had been returned to or retained by the deceased prior to her death and there is no cause for deduction or offset of the share of the estate to be distributed to RICHARD HOGAN.

VIII

REILLY SHEA HOGAN and HUNTER JAMES HOGAN are minor children of RICHARD HOGAN and CHRISTINE HOGAN. The Last Will and Testament provides that if the deceased dies before said children, that their inheritances shall be held in trust for their care, support, maintenance and education.

IX

The language of the will attempts to nominate a trustee for the minor children in the event that their father RICHARD HOGAN does not survive the deceased but makes no provision for who should be the trustee in the event that RICHARD HOGAN did survive the deceased, which is the case.

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The portions of the estate of the deceased that are to be distributed for the benefit of the minor children should be distributed to their lawful parents, RICHARD HOGAN and CHRISTINE HOGAN acting as Joint Trustees of the Estates of REILLY SHEA HOGAN and HUNTER JAMES HOGAN according to the conditions and instructions set forth in the Last Will and Testament of the deceased.

IX

The Deceased left her residence and a promissory note secured by a deed of trust.

Your Petitioners request that the Court order the Coexecutors to execute a deed for the property in Nye County to RICHARD HOGAN and CHRISTINE HOGAN as Trustees for HUNTER JAMES HOGAN, an assignment of the deed of trust to TRACY WEST, and a deed for the residence in three undivided one-third shares, one to RICHARD HOGAN and two undivided one third shares to the trustees for the minor heirs REILLY SHEA HOGAN and HUNTER JAMES HOGAN to be held for their benefit.

IIIX

The legal description of the residence located in Douglas County, Nevada is as follows:

XIV

The legal description of the real property subject to the deed of trust is as follows:

Lot 128, as set forth on the final Subdivision Map FSM-1006 of CHICHESTER ESTATES Phase 1, filed for record in the office of the County Recorder of Douglas County, State of Nevada, on September 12, 1995, in Book 995 at Page 1407, as Document No. 370215.

XV

The 1994 Buick Roadmaster should be distributed to TRACY WEST. The cash on hand, listed as \$56,089.31 in the Final Accounting filed herewith, should be distributed in four equal shares to the named heirs after payment of the costs of administration of this estate.

XVI

The balance of fees due for the legal services of the attorney for the Coexecutors, Peter J. Smith, is \$4,839.50 which has been determined to be reasonable and valid and is expected to be approved by the Court.

XVII

The Coexecutors claim their Executors' fees which are calculated according to statute, from the total of the assets shown on the Inventory filed herein, to be \$10,230 or \$5,115 for each Coexecutor.

XVIII

The Petitioners request that the Court direct the rest and residue of the estate to be distributed in undivided one third

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shares, one to RICHARD HOGAN and two to RICHARD HOGAN and CHRIS
TINE HOGAN as the trustees for the minor heirs REILLY SHEA HOGAN
and HUNTER JAMES HOGAN to be held for their benefit.

XIX

By distributing the note and deed of trust and the Buick to TRACY WEST, the cash in four equal shares and the residence and residue of personal property to RICHARD HOGAN and the two minor heirs in undivided thirds, the testamentary wishes of the deceased, that the residue of her estate be divided in one quarter shares, will be effectively though not exactly met.

XX

This estate is now ready for final distribution.

PRAYER

WHEREFORE The Coexecutors request that the Court find that this estate to be ready for final distribution, that they be directed to pay \$4,839.50 to Peter J. Smith, Esq. for the balance of his attorney's fees and costs, that the debts of the deceased shown as paid in the Final Accounting be approved by the Court, that the Court order payment of the Executors' fees, that the specific bequests of jewelry and adornments to be distributed to REILLY SHEA HOGAN, the real property in Duckwater be deeded to trustees for HUNTER JAMES HOGAN, the Twenty Dollar Gold piece and husband's diamond ring, if and when found, be distributed to HUNTER JAMES HOGAN, that the residue of the estate be distributed or deeded to the four named heirs as set forth above, and that RICHARD HOGAN and CHRISTINE HOGAN be declared the testamentary
