
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
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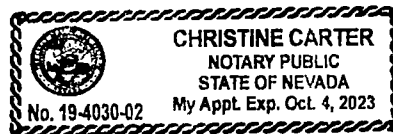

2. That said child's birth certificate be amended by entering the name of Shawn Hazen Wight as the father of said child and that the Court order the state registrar of vital statistics to prepare an amended certificate of birth consistent with this order.

3. An arrears Judgment is entered in the amount of \$2,293.00 for June 1, 2019 through September 30, 2020.

To be paid by payments of \$100.00 per month beginning October 1, 2020.

All payments MUST be made in the form of a money order, cashier's check or business check and payable to **STATE COLLECTION AND DISBURSEMENT UNIT (SCaDU)** and sent to:


