This Contract for services by an Independent Contractor (hereafter "Contract") is entered into by and between Douglas County, a political subdivision of the State of Nevada, (hereafter "County") through the Board of County Commissioners and TruePoint Solutions, a Nevada Corporation, Nevada Business ID# NV20111143 792 (hereafter "Contractor"). The County and Contractor are at times collectively referred to hereinafter as the "Parties" or individually as the "Party".

WHEREAS, Douglas County, a political subdivision of the State of Nevada, from time to time requires the services of independent contractors as authorized by Nevada Revised Statutes ("NRS") Chapters 244 and 332; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed the professional services of Contractor, herein specified are both necessary and desirable and in the best interests of Douglas County; and

WHEREAS, Contractor is duly qualified, equipped, staffed, ready, willing and able to perform and render the professional services hereinafter described;

Now, THEREFORE, in consideration of the agreements herein made, the parties mutually agree as follows:

- 1. EFFECTIVE DATE AND TERM OF CONTRACT. The Contract will become effective on the later date it is approved and signed by authorized representatives of the Parties and shall continue until December 31, 2021 unless terminated as set forth herein. Time is of the essence for performance of the professional services described herein.
- 2, INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR STATUS. The Parties agree that Contractor shall have the status of an independent contractor and that this Contract, by explicit agreement of the Parties, incorporates and applies the provisions of NRS 333.700 et. al., as necessarily adapted, to the Parties, including that Contractor is not an employee of the County and that

There shall be no:

- (1) Withholding of income taxes by the County;
- (2) Industrial insurance coverage provided by the County;
- (3) Participation in group insurance plans which may be available to employees of the County;
- (4) Participation or contributions by either the independent contractor or the

Page 1 of 7 Accela Platform County to the public employees retirement system;

- (5) Accumulation of vacation leave or sick leave; and
- (6) Unemployment compensation coverage provided by the County if the requirements of NRS 612.085 for independent contractors are met.
- 3. INDUSTRIAL INSURANCE. Contractor further agrees that prior to the commencement of any work and as a precondition to any obligation of the County to make any payment under the Contract, the Contractor will provide the County with a work certificate and/or a certificate issued by a qualified insurer in accordance with NRS 616B.627. Contractor also agrees, prior to commencing any work under the Contract, Contractor will complete and provide evidence to the County that the Contractor has made the following written request to Contractor's insurer:

<u>TruePoint Solutions</u> has entered into a contract with Douglas County to perform work from <u>January 1. 2021 to December 31. 2021</u> and requests that the authorized insurer provide to Douglas County: (!) A certificate of coverage issued pursuant to NRS 616B.627 and (2) notice of any lapse in coverage or nonpayment of coverage that the Contractor is required to maintain.

Contractor agrees to maintain required workers compensation coverage throughout the entire tem1 of this Contract. If Contractor does not maintain coverage throughout the entire tem1 of the Contract, Contractor agrees that the County may, at any time the coverage is not maintained by Contractor, order the Contractor to stop work, suspend the Contract, or terminate the Contract at the sole discretion of the County. For each six-month period this Contract is in effect, Contractor agrees, prior to the expiration of the six-month period, to provide another written request to the insurer for the provision of a certificate and notice of lapse in or nonpayment of coverage. If Contractor does not make the request or does not provide the certificate before the expiration of the six-month period, Contractor agrees that the County may order the Contractor to stop work, suspend the contract, or terminate the Contract at the sole discretion of the County.

- 4. SERVICES To BE PERFORMED. The Parties agree the professional services to be performed are the support and maintenance of the Accela Civic Platfom1 Modules for Building, Engineering, and Planning Divisions, as well as Accela Add-On products, all as further described in the attached On-going Service and SOW, which is incorporated herein as Exhibit "A." This Contract shall control over Exhibit A as to any conflicts, terms and conditions or interpretation which may arise.
- 5. PAYMENT FOR SERVICES. Contractor agrees to provide the professional services set forth in Paragraph 4 at a total cost not to exceed Forty-five Thousand Dollars (\$45,000) (the "Contract Price"). The Contract Price includes Two Hundred seventy-two (272) hours of labor. Unless Contractor has received a written exemption from the County, Contractor shall submit monthly requests for payment for services performed under this Contract. Requests for payment

- 17. STANDARD OF CARE. Contractor will perform all services in a manner consistent with any applicable licensing or professional rules and with that level of care and skill ordinarily exercised by other members of Contractor's profession currently practicing in the same locality under similar conditions.
- 18 WAIYER OF LIEN. Contractor understands and agrees that the services it will render to the County are not intended for the improvement of real property or to otherwise grant any rights to Contractor pursuant to NRS chapter 108.
- 19. THIRD PARTY BENEFICIARY. Nothing contained in this agreement is intended to convey any rights or to create a contractual relationship with any third party or to otherwise allow a third party to assert a cause of action against either Contractor or County.
- 20. NOTICES. All notices, requests, demands and other communications hereunder must be in writing and will be deemed delivered when sent via certified mail, return receipt requested or by commercial courier, provided the courier's regular business is delivery service and provided further that it guarantees delivery to the addressee by the end of the next business day following the courier's receipt from the sender, addressed as follows (or any other address that the Party to be notified may have designated to the sender by like notice):
