

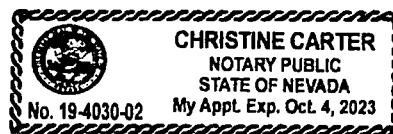

After considering all the evidence, the Master hereby makes the following Findings and Recommendations:

The Obligor was properly served on August 17, 2020, with a Notice and Finding of Financial and Parental Responsibility.

Obligee has named Obligor, Nathan Lakota Twohearts, as the father of Quentin William Kizer, born May 21, 2012.

1 Obligor was properly served and noticed of today's hearing at his last known address
2 and failed to appear.

3 Using Federal Poverty guidelines, Obligor's gross monthly earnings are up to **\$805.00**.
4 Pursuant to the formula prescribed within NRS 125B.080 and NAC 425 et seq., of
5 those earnings, the state calculates an obligation of **\$85.00** per month.

6 The monthly child support obligation recommended in paragraph 1 below is considered
7 based on the following provisions contained in NAC 425.150:

1 3. The Obligor shall pay \$85.00 per month in ongoing support beginning
2 March 1, 2021. The obligation for Child Support continues until the child turns 18
3 years of age, or until the child turns 19 years of age if the child is enrolled in High
4 School. However, this obligation to support a child is affected by a child's ability to
5 live on their own (NRS129.080 to 129.140 – legal emancipation) or when applicable,
6 continued financial support beyond the age of majority per NRS 125B.110.

7 4. An arrears Judgment is entered in the amount of \$6,069.00 for September 1, 2016
8 through February 28, 2021.

9 To be paid by payments of \$50.00 per month beginning March 1, 2021.

26 is not met by the amount withheld by your employer, you are responsible to pay the
27 difference between your court ordered obligation and the amount withheld by your
28 employer directly to the STATE COLLECTION AND DISBURSEMENT UNIT
(SCaDU). If you fail to do so you will be subject to the assessment of penalties and

1 interest. You may avoid these additional costs by making your current child support
2 payments each month.

3 6. The Obligee will cover the child's medical, vision, or dental health insurance needs
4 using either a private for fee insurance plan or public insurance plan. The accessible
5 and reasonable cost of medical support for the child is the amount of \$0.00 per month.
6 The Obligor will pay \$0.00 for the monthly medical cash support. NAC 425.135.

7 7. Pursuant to NRS 425.3824(1)(d) and NAC 425 et seq., expenses for health care
8 which are not reimbursed through insurance, including expenses for medical, surgical,
9 dental, orthodontic and optical expenses, must be shared equally by both parents. If a
10 parent seeks reimbursement for a child's medical/dental expense not covered by
11 insurance, that parent must send proof of the expense to the other parent within 30 days
12 of paying that bill. The other parent then has 30 days to reimburse the paying parent
13 1/2 the cost of that bill. The parents are required to comply with this provision for
14 reimbursement under this provision. The parents seeking enforcement of this provision
15 must either go to small claims court or district court to obtain a judgment against the
16 other parent before CSEP is required to collect on that judgment.

17 8. The Obligor shall pay and judgment is entered in favor of the Division of Welfare
18 Supportive Services for the reimbursement of genetic test fees totaling \$108.00, to be
19 paid by payments of \$10.00 per month beginning March 1, 2021.

20 9. The Obligor shall keep the Division of Welfare and Supportive Services informed of
21 any change regarding current residential and/or mailing address, employment and of
22 access to health insurance coverage in **WRITING** (including health insurance policy
23 information) within 10 days of such change.

24 10. Obligor shall be responsible for ALL child support and judgment payments due.

27 must make voluntary payments to the STATE COLLECTION AND DISBURSEMENT

1 11. Effective July 1, 2004 simple interest will accrue on all adjudicated arrears balances
2 (including payment in lieu of medical insurance) and spousal support balances, for
3 cases with a Nevada controlling order pursuant to NRS 99.040. Interest assessed by a
4 judgment of the court prior to July 1, 2004 will be enforced. Interest on the judgment
5 shall accrue at the rate established by NRS 125B.140(2)(c)(1).
