



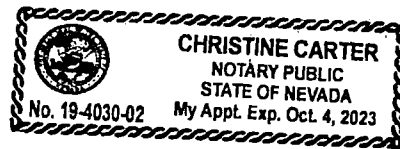

After considering all the evidence, the Master hereby makes the following Findings and Recommendations:

The Obligor was properly served on January 21, 2021, with a Notice and Finding of Financial and Parental Responsibility.

Obligee has named Obligor, Mylan William Schmidt, as the father of Julian O'Connor Schmidt, born March 16, 2018 and Sebastian William Schmidt, born February 27, 2019.

1 Obligor was properly served and noticed of today's hearing at his last known address
2 and failed to appear.

3 Using Federal poverty, Obligor's gross monthly earnings are up to \$805.00. Pursuant
4 to the formula prescribed within NRS 125B.080 and NAC 425 et seq., of those
5 earnings, the state calculates an obligation of \$117.00 per month.

4 consistent with this order.

5 3. The Obligor shall pay **\$117.00** per month in ongoing support beginning
6 April 1, 2021. The obligation for Child Support continues until the child turns 18 years
7 of age, or until the child turns 19 years of age if the child is enrolled in High School.
8 However, this obligation to support a child is affected by a child's ability to live on
9 their own (NRS129.080 to 129.140 – legal emancipation) or when applicable,
10 continued financial support beyond the age of majority per NRS 125B.110.

11 4. An arrears Judgment is entered in the amount of **\$683.00** for November 1, 2020
12 through March 31, 2021.

5. All payments shall be made by immediate income withholding. If your full obligation is not met by the amount withheld by your employer, you are responsible to pay the

1 difference between your court ordered obligation and the amount withheld by your
2 employer directly to the STATE COLLECTION AND DISBURSEMENT UNIT
3 (SCaDU). If you fail to do so you will be subject to the assessment of penalties and
4 interest. You may avoid these additional costs by making your current child support
5 payments each month.

6 6. The Obligee will cover the children's medical, vision, or dental health insurance
7 needs using either a private for fee insurance plan or public insurance plan. The
8 accessible and reasonable cost of medical support for the children is the amount of
9 \$0.00 per month. The Obligor will pay \$0.00 for the monthly medical cash support.
10 NAC 425.135.

11 7. Pursuant to NRS 425.3824(1)(d) and NAC 425 et seq., expenses for health care
12 which are not reimbursed through insurance, including expenses for medical, surgical,
13 dental, orthodontic and optical expenses, must be shared equally by both parents. If a
14 parent seeks reimbursement for a child's medical/dental expense not covered by
15 insurance, that parent must send proof of the expense to the other parent within 30 days
16 of paying that bill. The other parent then has 30 days to reimburse the paying parent
17 1/2 the cost of that bill. The parents are required to comply with this provision for
18 reimbursement under this provision. The parents seeking enforcement of this provision
19 must either go to small claims court or district court to obtain a judgment against the
20 other parent before CSEP is required to collect on that judgment.

21 8. The Obligor shall keep the Division of Welfare and Supportive Services informed of
22 any change regarding current residential and/or mailing address, employment and of
23 access to health insurance coverage in **WRITING** (including health insurance policy
24 information) within 10 days of such change.

25 9. Obligor shall be responsible for ALL child support and judgment payments due.
