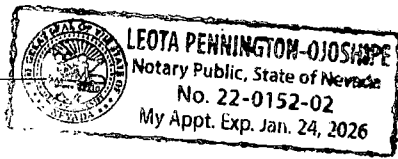

After considering all the evidence, the Master hereby makes the following Findings and Recommendations:

The Obligor is the parent of the following child:

1 Obligor was properly served and noticed of today's hearing at his last known address
2 and failed to appear.

3 Using Obligor's prior earnings from parties' Divorce Decree filed June 26, 2017 as
4 Obligor was not present to testify, Obligor's gross monthly earnings are \$3,418.00.
5 Pursuant to the formula prescribed within NRS 125B.080 and NAC 425 et seq., of
6 those earnings, the state calculates an obligation of \$615.30 per month.

7 The monthly child support obligation recommended in paragraph 1 below is adjusted
8 based on the following considerations contained in NAC 425.150:

18 The child support amount recommended by the Court Master (set out in paragraph 1
19 below) deviates from the statutory percentage under NAC 425 et seq., based on the
20 Obligor's cost of insurance for the child in the amount of N/A. NAC 425.135

21 The monthly child support amount recommended in paragraph 1 below deviates/is
22 adjusted from the statutory percentage under NRS 125B.080 and NAC 425 et seq.,

26 RECOMMENDED ORDER IS:

- 27 1. Ongoing support is ordered in the amount of \$615.30 per month beginning
28 February 1, 2022. The obligation for Child Support continues until the child turns 18
years of age, or until the child turns 19 years of age if the child is enrolled in High
School. NRS 425.300. However, this obligation to support a child is affected by a
child's ability to live on their own (NRS 129.080 to 129.140 – legal emancipation) or

1 when applicable, continued financial support beyond the age of majority per NRS
2 125B.110.

3 2. The Obligor is responsible for **child support** arrears for the period of
4 November 1, 2021 through January 31, 2022.

5 A judgment is entered against the Obligor for **child support** arrears as follows:

6 Principal in the amount of \$1,645.90

7 Interest in the amount of \$13.53

8 Penalty in the amount of \$0.00

9 For a total judgment of \$1,659.43 to be repaid at \$25.00 per month beginning February 1, 2022.

10 All payments MUST be made in the form of a money order, cashier's check or business check

21 **PAYMENT OF SUPPORT IS TO BE AS PROVIDED HEREIN, AND THE GIVING OF**
22 **GIFTS, OF MAKING PURCHASES OF FOOD, CLOTHING AND THE LIKE WILL**
23 **NOT FULFILL THE OBLIGATION. NOTICE: NO CREDIT WILL BE GIVEN FOR**
24 **PAYMENTS PAID DIRECTLY TO THE OBLIGEE.**

25 3. All payments shall be made by immediate income withholding. If your full obligation
26 is not met by the amount withheld by your employer, you are responsible to pay the
27 difference between your court ordered obligation and the amount withheld by your
28 employer directly to the STATE COLLECTION AND DISBURSEMENT UNIT
(SCaDU). If you fail to do so you will be subject to the assessment of penalties and

1 interest. You may avoid these additional costs by making your current child support
2 payments each month.

3 4. The Obligee will cover the child's medical, vision, or dental health insurance needs
4 using either a private for fee insurance plan or public insurance plan. The accessible
5 and reasonable cost of medical support for the child is the amount of \$0.00 per month.
6 The Obligor will pay \$0.00 for the monthly medical cash support. NAC 425.135.

7 5. Pursuant NRS 425.382 et seq. and NAC 425 et seq., expenses for health care which
8 are not reimbursed through insurance, including expenses for medical, surgical, dental,
9 orthodontic and optical expenses, must be shared equally by both parents. If a parent
10 seeks reimbursement for a child's medical/dental expense not covered by insurance, that
11 parent must send proof of the expense to the other parent within 30 days of paying that
12 bill. The other parent then has 30 days to reimburse the paying parent 1/2 the cost of
13 that bill. The parents are required to comply with this provision for reimbursement
14 under this provision. The parents seeking enforcement of this provision must either go
15 to small claims court or district court to obtain a judgment against the other parent
16 before CSEP is required to collect on that judgment.

17 6. The Obligor shall keep the Division of Welfare and Supportive Services informed of
18 any change regarding current residential and/or mailing address, employment and of
19 access to health insurance coverage in WRITING (including health insurance policy
20 information) within 10 days of such change.

21 7. Obligor shall be responsible for ALL child support and judgment payments due.
22 Payment is to be made directly to the STATE COLLECTION AND
23 DISBURSEMENT UNIT (SCaDU). At any time withholding does not occur, Obligor
24 must make voluntary payments to the STATE COLLECTION AND DISBURSEMENT
25 UNIT (SCaDU).

26 8. Effective July 1, 2004 simple interest will accrue on all adjudicated arrears balances
27 (including payment in lieu of medical insurance) and spousal support balances, for
28 cases with a Nevada controlling order pursuant to NRS 99.040. Interest assessed by a

1 judgment of the court prior to July 1, 2004 will be enforced. Interest on the judgment
2 shall accrue at the rate established by NRS 125B.140(2)(c)(1).

3 9. A 10% penalty will be assessed on each unpaid installment, or portion thereof, of an
4 obligation to pay child support for a child, pursuant to NRS 125B.095 until January 31,
5 2020. All penalties accrued through that date will be enforced/collected until the
6 amount is paid in full.

7 10. The State of Nevada has continuing exclusive jurisdiction for enforcement and
8 modification purposes pursuant to the Full Faith and Credit for Child Support Orders
9 Act.

10 11. The Master finds that these Recommendations are in the best interest of the child.


