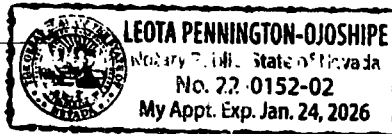

This matter was heard on March 18, 2022, for a review hearing set at December 17, 2021 hearing. The Court Master with the following were present:

After considering all the evidence, the Master hereby makes the following Findings and

Recommendations:

The Obligor is the parent of the following children:

- 1  Obligor was properly served and noticed of today's hearing at his/her last known  
2 address and failed to appear.
- 3  Using federal poverty guidelines, Obligor's gross monthly earnings are up to \$849.00.  
4 Pursuant to the formula prescribed within NRS 125B.080 and NAC 425 et seq., of  
5 those earnings, the state calculates an obligation of \$90.00 per month.

6 RECOMMENDED ORDER IS:

- 7 1.  Ongoing support is ordered in the amount of \$90.00 per month beginning  
8 March 1, 2022. The obligation for Child Support continues until the child turns 18  
9 years of age, or until the child turns 19 years of age if the child is enrolled in High  
10 School. NRS 425.300. However, this obligation to support a child is affected by a  
11 child's ability to live on their own (NRS129.080 to 129.140 – legal emancipation) or  
12 when applicable, continued financial support beyond the age of majority per NRS  
13 125B.110.
- 14 2.  The Obligor is responsible for **child support** arrears for the period of  
15 December 1, 2021 through February 28, 2022.
- 16  A judgment is entered against the Obligor for **child support** arrears as follows:  
17  Principal in the amount of \$52,194.36  
18  Interest in the amount of \$11,848.35  
19  Penalty in the amount of \$3,452.69

20 For a total judgment of \$67,495.40 to be repaid at \$230.00 per month beginning  
21 March 1, 2022.

22 All payments MUST be made in the form of a money order, cashier's check or business check  
23 and payable to **STATE COLLECTION AND DISBURSEMENT UNIT (SCaDU)** and sent  
24 to:

28 The following information must be included with each payment:

- A. Name (first, middle, last) of person responsible for paying child support.

1 B. Social Security Number of person responsible for paying child support.

2 C. Child support case number 385-98-1200B listed on each payment.

3 D. Name of custodian (first and last name of person receiving child support).

4 **PAYMENT OF SUPPORT IS TO BE AS PROVIDED HEREIN, AND THE GIVING OF**  
5 **GIFTS, OF MAKING PURCHASES OF FOOD, CLOTHING AND THE LIKE WILL**  
6 **NOT FULFILL THE OBLIGATION. NOTICE: NO CREDIT WILL BE GIVEN FOR**  
7 **PAYMENTS PAID DIRECTLY TO THE OBLIGEE.**

8 4. All payments shall be made by immediate income withholding. If your full obligation  
9 is not met by the amount withheld by your employer, you are responsible to pay the  
10 difference between your court ordered obligation and the amount withheld by your  
11 employer directly to the STATE COLLECTION AND DISBURSEMENT UNIT  
12 (SCaDU). If you fail to do so you will be subject to the assessment of penalties and  
13 interest. You may avoid these additional costs by making your current child support  
14 payments each month.

15 5.  The Obligee will cover the child(ren)'s medical, vision, or dental health insurance  
16 needs using either a private for fee insurance plan or public insurance plan. The  
17 accessible and reasonable cost of medical support for the child(ren) is the amount of  
18 **\$0.00** per month. The Obligor will pay **\$0.00** for the monthly medical cash support.  
19 NAC 425.135.

20 6.  Pursuant NRS 425.382 et seq. and NAC 425 et seq., expenses for health care which  
21 are not reimbursed through insurance, including expenses for medical, surgical, dental,  
22 orthodontic and optical expenses, must be shared equally by both parents. If a parent  
23 seeks reimbursement for a child's medical/dental expense not covered by insurance, that  
24 parent must send proof of the expense to the other parent within 30 days of paying that  
25 bill. The other parent then has 30 days to reimburse the paying parent 1/2 the cost of  
26 that bill. The parents are required to comply with this provision for reimbursement  
27 under this provision. The parents seeking enforcement of this provision must either go  
28

1 to small claims court or district court to obtain a judgment against the other parent  
2 before CSEP is required to collect on that judgment.

3 7. The Obligor shall keep the Division of Welfare and Supportive Services informed of  
4 any change regarding current residential and/or mailing address, employment and of  
5 access to health insurance coverage in WRITING (including health insurance policy  
6 information) within 10 days of such change.

7 8. Obligor shall be responsible for ALL child support and judgment payments due.  
8 Payment is to be made directly to the STATE COLLECTION AND  
9 DISBURSEMENT UNIT (SCaDU). At any time withholding does not occur, Obligor  
10 must make voluntary payments to the STATE COLLECTION AND DISBURSEMENT  
11 UNIT (SCaDU).

12 9. Effective July 1, 2004 simple interest will accrue on all adjudicated arrears balances  
13 (including payment in lieu of medical insurance) and spousal support balances, for  
14 cases with a Nevada controlling order pursuant to NRS 99.040. Interest assessed by a  
15 judgment of the court prior to July 1, 2004 will be enforced. Interest on the judgment  
16 shall accrue at the rate established by NRS 125B.140(2)(c)(1).

17 10. A 10% penalty will be assessed on each unpaid installment, or portion thereof, of an  
18 obligation to pay child support for a child, pursuant to NRS 125B.095 until January 31,  
19 2020. All penalties accrued through that date will be enforced/collected until the  
20 amount is paid in full.

21 11. The State of Nevada has continuing exclusive jurisdiction for enforcement and  
22 modification purposes pursuant to the Full Faith and Credit for Child Support Orders  
23 Act.

24 12. The Master finds that these Recommendations are in the best interest of the child(ren).

**NOTICE:** Pursuant to NAC 425.165, if you want to adjust the amount of child support established in this order, you **MUST** file a motion to modify the order with or submit a stipulation to the court. If a motion to modify the order is not filed or a stipulation is not submitted, the child support obligation established in this order will continue until such time as all children who are the subject of this order reach 18 years of age or, if the youngest child who is subject to this order is still in high school when he or she reaches 18 years of age, when the child graduates from high school or reaches 19 years of age, whichever comes first. Unless the parties agree otherwise in a stipulation, any modification made pursuant to a motion to modify the order will be effective as of the date the motion was filed. Unless a stay of this Order is obtained from District Court, all enforcement procedures including, but not limited to wage withholding, garnishment, liens and the attachment of federal income tax returns will be undertaken upon entry of this order.
