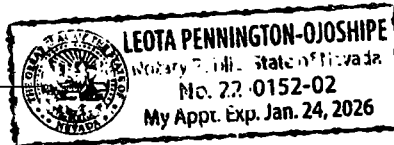

25 After considering all the evidence, the Master hereby makes the following Findings and

26 Recommendations:

1 The Obligor is the parent of the following children:

7 Using Obligor's statement, Obligor's gross monthly earnings are \$2,400.00. Pursuant
8 to the formula prescribed within NRS 125B.080 and NAC 425 et seq., 28% of those
9 earnings, the state calculates an obligation of \$672.00 per month.

10 The monthly child support obligation recommended in paragraph 1 below is adjusted
11 based on the following considerations contained in NAC 425.150:

21 RECOMMENDED ORDER IS:

22 1. Ongoing support is ordered in the amount of \$672.00 per month beginning
23 March 1, 2022. The obligation for Child Support continues until the child turns 18
24 years of age, or until the child turns 19 years of age if the child is enrolled in High
25 School. NRS 425.300. However, this obligation to support a child is affected by a
26 child's ability to live on their own (NRS129.080 to 129.140 – legal emancipation) or
27 when applicable, continued financial support beyond the age of majority per NRS
28 125B.110.

2. The Obligor is responsible for **child support** arrears for the period of
October 1, 2017, through February 28, 2022.

A judgment is entered against the Obligor for **child support** arrears as follows:

Principal in the amount of \$49,537.92

1 Interest in the amount of \$5,693.13

2 Penalty in the amount of \$2,168.35

3 For a total judgment of \$57,399.40 to be repaid at \$220.00 per month beginning
4 March 1, 2022.

5 All payments MUST be made in the form of a money order, cashier's check or business check
6 and payable to **STATE COLLECTION AND DISBURSEMENT UNIT (SCaDU)** and sent

11 The following information must be included with each payment:

12 A. Name (first, middle, last) of person responsible for paying child support.

13 B. Social Security Number of person responsible for paying child support.

14 C. Child support case number 223966200A listed on each payment.

15 D. Name of custodian (first and last name of person receiving child support).

16 **PAYMENT OF SUPPORT IS TO BE AS PROVIDED HEREIN, AND THE GIVING OF**
17 **GIFTS, OF MAKING PURCHASES OF FOOD, CLOTHING AND THE LIKE WILL**
18 **NOT FULFILL THE OBLIGATION. NOTICE: NO CREDIT WILL BE GIVEN FOR**
19 **PAYMENTS PAID DIRECTLY TO THE OBLIGEE.**

20 3. All payments shall be made by immediate income withholding. If your full obligation
21 is not met by the amount withheld by your employer, you are responsible to pay the
22 difference between your court ordered obligation and the amount withheld by your
23 employer directly to the STATE COLLECTION AND DISBURSEMENT UNIT
24 (SCaDU). If you fail to do so you will be subject to the assessment of penalties and
25 interest. You may avoid these additional costs by making your current child support
26 payments each month.

27 4. The Obligee will cover the child(ren)'s medical, vision, or dental health insurance
28 needs using either a private for fee insurance plan or public insurance plan. The
accessible and reasonable cost of medical support for the child(ren) is the amount of

1 \$0.00 per month. The Obligor will pay \$0.00 for the monthly medical cash support.

2 NAC 425.135.

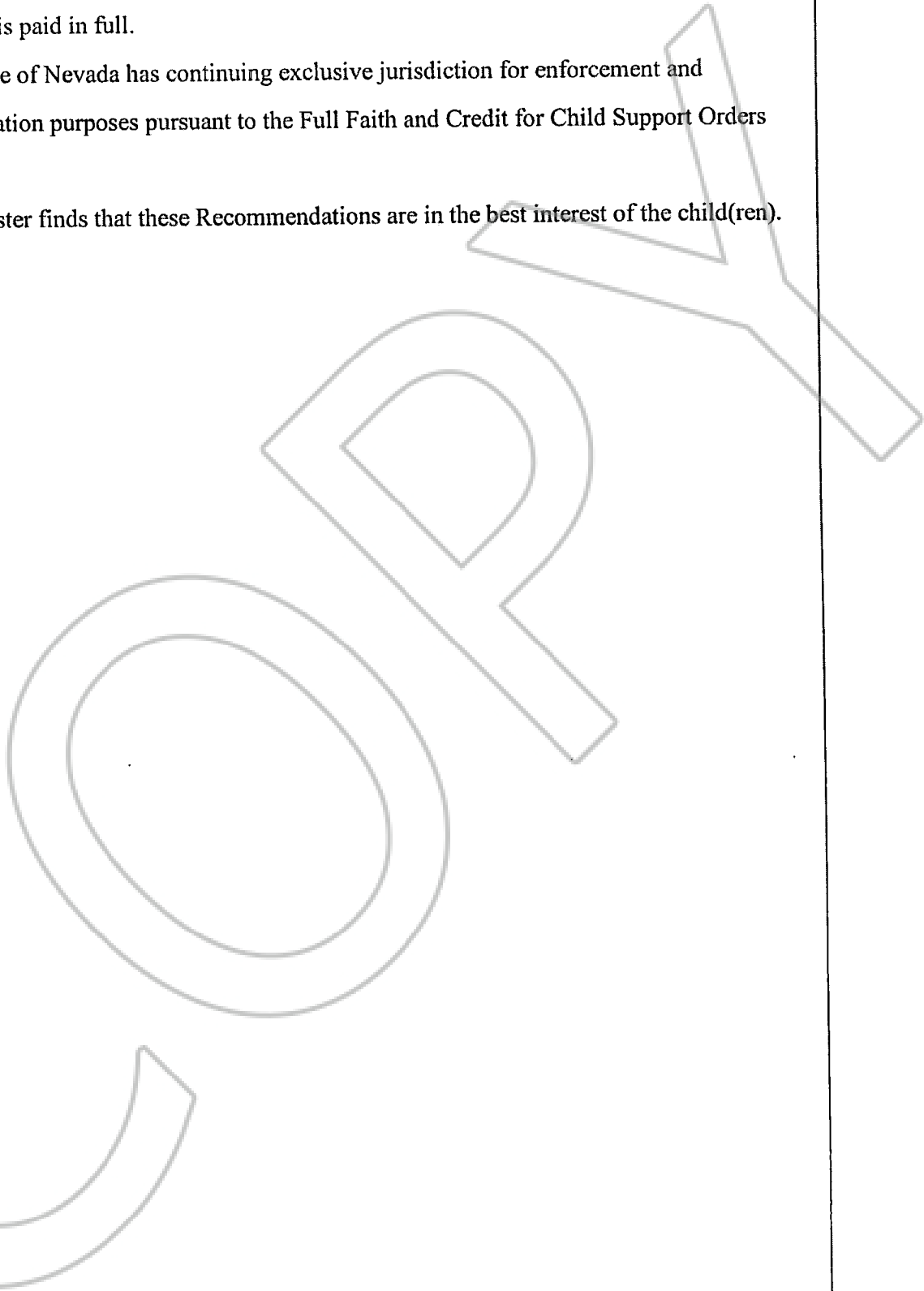
- 3 5. Pursuant NRS 425.382 et seq. and NAC 425 et seq., expenses for health care which
4 are not reimbursed through insurance, including expenses for medical, surgical, dental,
5 orthodontic and optical expenses, must be shared equally by both parents. If a parent
6 seeks reimbursement for a child's medical/dental expense not covered by insurance, that
7 parent must send proof of the expense to the other parent within 30 days of paying that
8 bill. The other parent then has 30 days to reimburse the paying parent 1/2 the cost of
9 that bill. The parents are required to comply with this provision for reimbursement
10 under this provision. The parents seeking enforcement of this provision must either go
11 to small claims court or district court to obtain a judgment against the other parent
12 before CSEP is required to collect on that judgment.
- 13 6. The Obligor shall keep the Division of Welfare and Supportive Services informed of
14 any change regarding current residential and/or mailing address, employment and of
15 access to health insurance coverage in WRITING (including health insurance policy
16 information) within 10 days of such change.
- 17 7. Obligor shall be responsible for ALL child support and judgment payments due.
18 Payment is to be made directly to the STATE COLLECTION AND
19 DISBURSEMENT UNIT (SCaDU). At any time withholding does not occur, Obligor
20 must make voluntary payments to the STATE COLLECTION AND DISBURSEMENT
21 UNIT (SCaDU).
- 22 8. Effective July 1, 2004 simple interest will accrue on all adjudicated arrears balances
23 (including payment in lieu of medical insurance) and spousal support balances, for
24 cases with a Nevada controlling order pursuant to NRS 99.040. Interest assessed by a
25 judgment of the court prior to July 1, 2004 will be enforced. Interest on the judgment
26 shall accrue at the rate established by NRS 125B.140(2)(c)(1).
- 27 9. A 10% penalty will be assessed on each unpaid installment, or portion thereof, of an
28 obligation to pay child support for a child, pursuant to NRS 125B.095 until January 31,

1 2020. All penalties accrued through that date will be enforced/collected until the
2 amount is paid in full.

3 10. The State of Nevada has continuing exclusive jurisdiction for enforcement and
4 modification purposes pursuant to the Full Faith and Credit for Child Support Orders
5 Act.

6 11. The Master finds that these Recommendations are in the best interest of the child(ren).

Pursuant to NRS 125B.145 this Order may be reviewed every three (3) years and is subject to future modifications.

NOTICE: Pursuant to NAC 425.165, if you want to adjust the amount of child support established in this order, you MUST file a motion to modify the order with or submit a stipulation to the court. If a motion to modify the order is not filed or a stipulation is not submitted, the child support obligation established in this order will continue until such time as all children who are the subject of this order reach 18 years of age or, if the youngest child who is subject to this order is still in high school when he or she reaches 18 years of age, when the child graduates from high school or reaches 19 years of age, whichever comes first. Unless the parties agree otherwise in a stipulation, any modification made pursuant to a motion to modify the order will be effective as of the date the motion was filed. Unless a stay of this Order is obtained from District Court, all enforcement procedures including, but not limited to wage withholding, garnishment, liens and the attachment of federal income tax returns will be undertaken upon entry of this order.
