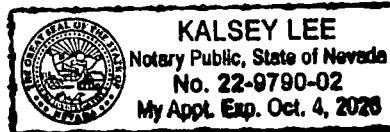

**JUDGMENT AND ORDER**

This matter was heard on November 18, 2022 for the Notice and Finding of Financial Responsibility. The Court Master with the following were present:

After considering all the evidence, the Master hereby makes the following Findings and Recommendations:

The Obligor was properly served on August 3, 2022, with a Notice and Finding of Financial Responsibility.

Obligor is the parent of Eva Lynn Fite, born December 4, 2021.

1  Using actual earnings, Obligor's gross monthly earnings are \$8,113.00. Pursuant to the  
2 formula prescribed within NRS 125B.080 and NAC 425 et seq., 16% of those earnings,  
3 the state calculates an obligation of \$1,129.00 per month.

4  The monthly child support obligation recommended in paragraph 1 below is considered  
5 based on the following provisions contained in NAC 425.150:

6 Any special educational needs of the child:	<u>N/A;</u>
7 The legal responsibility of the parties for the support of others:	<u>\$129.00;</u>
8 The value of services contributed by either party:	<u>N/A;</u>
9 Any public assistance paid to support the child:	<u>N/A;</u>
10 The cost of transportation of the child to and from visitation:	<u>N/A;</u>
11 The relative income of both households:	<u>N/A;</u>
12 Any other necessary expenses for the benefit of the child:	<u>N/A;</u>
13 The Obligor's ability to pay:	<u>N/A;</u>
14 The child(ren)'s derivative benefit from a federal public benefit:	<u>N/A.</u>

12  The monthly child support amount recommended in paragraph 1 below deviates/is  
13 adjusted from the statutory percentage under NRS 125B.080 and NAC 425 et seq., based  
14 on the reasonable cost of childcare in amount of \$800.00 and the Obligor will share the  
15 equitable amount of \$400.00 as part of the monthly child support obligation. NAC  
16 425.130.

17 THE RECOMMENDED ORDER:

- 18 1.  The Obligor shall pay \$1,400.00 per month in ongoing support beginning  
19 December 1, 2022. The obligation for Child Support continues until the child turns 18  
20 years of age, or until the child turns 19 years of age if the child is enrolled in High  
21 School. However, this obligation to support a child is affected by a child's ability to live  
22 on their own (NRS129.080 to 129.140 – legal emancipation) or when applicable,  
23 continued financial support beyond the age of majority per NRS 125B.110.
- 24 2.  An arrears Judgment is entered in the amount of \$8,400.00 for February 1, 2022  
25 through November 30, 2022.
- 26  To be paid by payments of \$100.00 per month beginning December 1, 2022.

1 All payments MUST be made in the form of a money order, cashier's check or business check

7 The following information must be included with each payment:

- 8 A. Name (first, middle, last) of person responsible for paying child support.
- 9 B. Social Security Number of person responsible for paying child support.
- 10 C. Child support case number 3200018535 listed on each payment.
- 11 D. Name of custodian (first and last name of person receiving child support).

12 **PAYMENT OF SUPPORT IS TO BE AS PROVIDED HEREIN, AND THE GIVING OF**  
13 **GIFTS, OF MAKING PURCHASES OF FOOD, CLOTHING AND THE LIKE WILL**  
14 **NOT FULFILL THE OBLIGATION. NOTICE: NO CREDIT WILL BE GIVEN FOR**  
15 **PAYMENTS PAID DIRECTLY TO THE OBLIGEE.**

16 3. All payments shall be made by immediate income withholding. If your full obligation is  
17 not met by the amount withheld by your employer, you are responsible to pay the  
18 difference between your court ordered obligation and the amount withheld by your  
19 employer or at any time withholding does not occur, you are responsible to make  
20 voluntary payments to the STATE COLLECTION AND DISBURSEMENT UNIT  
21 (SCaDU). If you fail to do so you will be subject to the assessment of penalties and  
22 interest. You may avoid these additional costs by making your current child support  
23 payments each month.

24 4.  The Obligor shall provide health insurance coverage for the child when available  
25 under a plan that is reasonable in cost as defined in NRS 425.3824(1)(d) and NAC 425  
26 et seq. The Obligor shall also provide assistance in obtaining payment for insured  
27 services.

28 5.  Pursuant to NRS 425.3824(1)(d) and NAC 425 et seq., expenses for health care  
which are not reimbursed through insurance, including expenses for medical, surgical,  
dental, orthodontic and optical expenses, must be shared equally by both parents. If a

1 parent seeks reimbursement for a child's medical/dental expense not covered by  
2 insurance, that parent must send proof of the expense to the other parent within 30 days  
3 of paying that bill. The other parent then has 30 days to reimburse the paying parent 1/2  
4 the cost of that bill. The parents are required to comply with this provision for  
5 reimbursement under this provision. The parents seeking enforcement of this provision  
6 must either go to small claims court or district court to obtain a judgment against the  
7 other parent before CSEP is required to collect on that judgment.

8 6. The Obligor shall keep the Division of Welfare and Supportive Services informed of any  
9 change regarding current residential and/or mailing address, employment and of access  
10 to health insurance coverage in **WRITING** (including health insurance policy  
11 information) within 10 days of such change.

12 7. Effective July 1, 2004 simple interest will accrue on all adjudicated arrears balances  
13 (including payment in lieu of medical insurance) and spousal support balances, for cases  
14 with a Nevada controlling order pursuant to NRS 99.040. Interest assessed by a  
15 judgment of the court prior to July 1, 2004 will be enforced. Interest on the judgment  
16 shall accrue at the rate established by NRS 125B.140(2)(c)(1).

17 8. The State of Nevada has continuing exclusive jurisdiction for enforcement and  
18 modification purposes pursuant to the Full Faith and Credit for Child Support Orders  
19 Act.

20 9. The Master finds that these Recommendations are in the best interest of the child(ren).

21 It is further ordered that: See page 2; lines 4-16. All amounts and adjustments were stipulated to  
22 between the parties and counsel.

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1 **SUPPORT OBLIGATION BREAKDOWN AS FOLLOWS:**

6 Pursuant to NRS 125B.145 this Order may be reviewed every three (3) years and is subject to  
7 future modifications.

8 **NOTICE:** Pursuant to NAC 425.165, if you want to adjust the amount of child support  
9 established in this order, you **MUST** file a motion to modify the order with or submit a  
10 stipulation to the court. If a motion to modify the order is not filed or a stipulation is not  
11 submitted, the child support obligation established in this order will continue until such time  
12 as all children who are the subject of this order reach 18 years of age or, if the youngest child  
13 who is subject to this order is still in high school when he or she reaches 18 years of age,  
14 when the child graduates from high school or reaches 19 years of age, whichever comes first.

15 Unless the parties agree otherwise in a stipulation, any modification made pursuant to a  
16 motion to modify the order will be effective as of the date the motion was filed.

17 Unless a stay of this Order is obtained from District Court, all enforcement procedures  
18 including, but not limited to wage withholding, garnishment, liens and the attachment of  
19 federal income tax returns will be undertaken upon entry of this order.
