Recommendations:

The Obligor was properly served on <u>February 9, 2023</u>, with a Notice and Finding of Financial and Responsibility.

Obligor is the parent of <u>Maximus Benjamin Cuevas</u>, born <u>April 10, 2007</u> and <u>Nicholas Ezequiel</u> <u>Cuevas</u> born <u>April 29, 2009</u>.

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### the formula prescribed within NRS 125B.080 and NAC 425 et seq., 22% of those earnings, the state calculates an obligation of \$489.00 per month.

- The Obligor shall pay \$489.00 per month in ongoing support beginning June 1, 2023. All payments shall be made by immediate income withholding. If your full obligation is not met by the amount withheld by your employer, you are responsible to pay the

difference between your court ordered obligation and the amount withheld by your employer or at any time withholding does not occur, you are responsible to make voluntary payments to the STATE COLLECTION AND DISBURSEMENT UNIT (SCaDU). If you fail to do so you will be subject to the assessment of penalties and interest. You may avoid these additional costs by making your current child support payments each month.

- The Obligee will cover the children's medical, vision, or dental health insurance needs using either a private for fee insurance plan or public insurance plan. The accessible and reasonable cost of medical support for the child(ren) is the amount of \$0.00 per month. The Obligor will pay \$0.00 for the monthly medical cash support effective June 1, 2023. NAC 425.135.
- Pursuant to NRS 425.3824(1)(d) and NAC 425 et seq., Obligor is responsible for one half of all expenses for health care which are not reimbursed through insurance, including expenses for medical, surgical, dental, orthodontic and optical expenses. If a parent seeks reimbursement for a child's medical/dental expense not covered by insurance, that parent must send proof of the expense to the other parent within 30 days of paying that bill. The other parent then has 30 days to reimburse the paying parent 1/2 the cost of that bill. The parents are required to comply with this provision for reimbursement under this provision. The parents seeking enforcement of this provision must either go to small claims court or district court to obtain a judgment against the other parent before CSEP is required to collect on that judgment.
- 6. The Obligor shall keep the Division of Welfare and Supportive Services informed of any change regarding current residential and/or mailing address, employment and of access to health insurance coverage in **WRITING** (including health insurance policy information) within 10 days of such change.
- 7. Effective July 1, 2004 simple interest will accrue on all adjudicated arrears balances (including payment in lieu of medical insurance) and spousal support balances, for cases with a Nevada controlling order pursuant to NRS 99.040. Interest assessed by a
