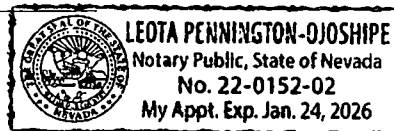

18 This matter was heard on May 12, 2023 for the Notice and Finding of Financial
19 Responsibility. The Court Master with the following were present:

23 After considering all the evidence, the Master hereby makes the following Findings and
24 Recommendations:

25 The Obligor was properly served on February 9, 2023, with a Notice and Finding of Financial
26 and Responsibility.

27 Obligor is the parent of Maximus Benjamin Cuevas, born April 10, 2007 and Nicholas Ezequiel
28 Cuevas born April 29, 2009.

1 Using Obligor's testimony, Obligor's gross monthly earnings are \$2,221.00. Pursuant to
2 the formula prescribed within NRS 125B.080 and NAC 425 et seq., 22% of those
3 earnings, the state calculates an obligation of \$489.00 per month.

4 THE RECOMMENDED ORDER:

5 1. The Obligor shall pay \$489.00 per month in ongoing support beginning June 1, 2023.

6 The obligation for Child Support continues until the child turns 18 years of age, or until
7 the child turns 19 years of age if the child is enrolled in High School. However, this
8 obligation to support a child is affected by a child's ability to live on their own
9 (NRS129.080 to 129.140 – legal emancipation) or when applicable, continued financial
10 support beyond the age of majority per NRS 125B.110.

11 2. An arrears Judgment is entered in the amount of \$4,948.00 for November 1, 2021
12 through May 31, 2023.

13 To be paid by payments of \$20.00 per month beginning June 1, 2023.

14 All payments MUST be made in the form of a money order, cashier's check or business check
15 and payable to **STATE COLLECTION AND DISBURSEMENT UNIT (SCaDU)** and sent
16 to:

17 **STATE COLLECTION AND DISBURSEMENT UNIT (SCaDU)**

19 **LAS VEGAS, NV 89193-89501**

20 The following information must be included with each payment:

- 21 A. Name (first, middle, last) of person responsible for paying child support.
22 B. Social Security Number of person responsible for paying child support.
23 C. Child support case number 3200017767 listed on each payment.
24 D. Name of custodian (first and last name of person receiving child support).

25 **PAYMENT OF SUPPORT IS TO BE AS PROVIDED HEREIN, AND THE GIVING OF**
26 **GIFTS, OF MAKING PURCHASES OF FOOD, CLOTHING AND THE LIKE WILL**
27 **NOT FULFILL THE OBLIGATION. NOTICE: NO CREDIT WILL BE GIVEN FOR**
28 **PAYMENTS PAID DIRECTLY TO THE OBLIGEE.**

3. All payments shall be made by immediate income withholding. If your full obligation is not met by the amount withheld by your employer, you are responsible to pay the

1 difference between your court ordered obligation and the amount withheld by your
2 employer or at any time withholding does not occur, you are responsible to make
3 voluntary payments to the STATE COLLECTION AND DISBURSEMENT UNIT
4 (SCaDU). If you fail to do so you will be subject to the assessment of penalties and
5 interest. You may avoid these additional costs by making your current child support
6 payments each month.

- 7 4. The Obligee will cover the children's medical, vision, or dental health insurance
8 needs using either a private for fee insurance plan or public insurance plan. The
9 accessible and reasonable cost of medical support for the child(ren) is the amount of
10 **\$0.00** per month. The Obligor will pay **\$0.00** for the monthly medical cash support
11 effective June 1, 2023. NAC 425.135.
- 12 5. Pursuant to NRS 425.3824(1)(d) and NAC 425 et seq., Obligor is responsible for one
13 half of all expenses for health care which are not reimbursed through insurance,
14 including expenses for medical, surgical, dental, orthodontic and optical expenses. If a
15 parent seeks reimbursement for a child's medical/dental expense not covered by
16 insurance, that parent must send proof of the expense to the other parent within 30 days
17 of paying that bill. The other parent then has 30 days to reimburse the paying parent 1/2
18 the cost of that bill. The parents are required to comply with this provision for
19 reimbursement under this provision. The parents seeking enforcement of this provision
20 must either go to small claims court or district court to obtain a judgment against the
21 other parent before CSEP is required to collect on that judgment.
- 22 6. The Obligor shall keep the Division of Welfare and Supportive Services informed of any
23 change regarding current residential and/or mailing address, employment and of access
24 to health insurance coverage in **WRITING** (including health insurance policy
25 information) within 10 days of such change.
- 26 7. Effective July 1, 2004 simple interest will accrue on all adjudicated arrears balances
27 (including payment in lieu of medical insurance) and spousal support balances, for cases
28 with a Nevada controlling order pursuant to NRS 99.040. Interest assessed by a

1 judgment of the court prior to July 1, 2004 will be enforced. Interest on the judgment
2 shall accrue at the rate established by NRS 125B.140(2)(c)(1).

3 8. The State of Nevada has continuing exclusive jurisdiction for enforcement and
4 modification purposes pursuant to the Full Faith and Credit for Child Support Orders
5 Act.

6 9. The Master finds that these Recommendations are in the best interest of the children.

7 It is further ordered that: Interest will not accrue on arrears.

5 stipulation to the court. If a motion to modify the order is not filed or a stipulation is not
6 submitted, the child support obligation established in this order will continue until such time
7 as all children who are the subject of this order reach 18 years of age or, if the youngest child
8 who is subject to this order is still in high school when he or she reaches 18 years of age,
9 when the child graduates from high school or reaches 19 years of age, whichever comes first.

10 Unless the parties agree otherwise in a stipulation, any modification made pursuant to a
11 motion to modify the order will be effective as of the date the motion was filed.

12 Unless a stay of this Order is obtained from District Court, all enforcement procedures
13 including, but not limited to wage withholding, garnishment, liens and the attachment of
14 federal income tax returns will be undertaken upon entry of this order.


